# CHAPTER 20

# An Act respecting Certain Amendments to Certain Acts resulting from the enactment of The Homesteads Act, 1989

#### (Assented to July 17, 1989)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title 1 This Act may be cited as <u>The Homesteads Consequential Amendment Act</u>, 1989.

6 The Mentally Disordered Persons Act is amended:

(a) by striking out "The Homesteads Act":

- (i) in clause 18(b.2); and
- (ii) in section 18.1;
- and substituting "The Homesteads Act, 1989";

clause 18.1(a) and substituting in each case "non-owning spouse as defined in that Act";

(c) by repealing clause 18.1(b) and substituting the following clause:

"(b) where the committee submits his or her affidavit in compliance with section 8 of <u>The Homesteads Act</u>, <u>1989</u>;"; and

- (d) by repealing clause 18.1(c) and substituting the following clause:
  - "(c) where the committee:
    - (i) is examined by:

(A) a judge of the Provincial Court of Saskatchewan, the court or the Court of Appeal;

(B) a presiding justice of the peace, or a non-presiding justice of the peace appointed or continued in office pursuant to <u>The</u> Justices of the Peace Act, 1988;

(C) a solicitor entitled to practise law pursuant to <u>The Legal</u> <u>Profession Act</u>; or

(D) a notary public appointed pursuant to <u>The Notaries Public</u> <u>Act</u>; and

(ii) acknowledges:

(A) that he or she understands the rights of the mentally disordered person in the homestead and intends to give them up; and

(B) that he or she signs the instrument of his or her own free will and consent and without compulsion on the part of the spouse of the mentally disordered person".

Compliance with The Homesteads Act, 1989

"46(1) Where the registered owner or the non-owning spouse, as defined in <u>The</u> <u>Homesteads Act, 1989</u>, of the registered owner of land is an infant or a person of whose property the public trustee is committee, and the public trustee considers it necessary or advisable to sign an agreement for sale, transfer, lease, mortgage or other instrument and compliance with <u>The Homesteads Act, 1989</u> is required, the public trustee is deemed to have complied with the provisions of that Act where:

(a) the owner has a non-owning spouse as defined in that Act:

(i) who refuses to sign the instrument; or

(ii) whose whereabouts is unknown and who cannot be found after a reasonable search;

and the public trustee obtains an order of the court dispensing with the consent and acknowledgment of the non-owning spouse and complies with any terms and conditions that the judge may direct;

(b) the public trustee submits his or her affidavit in compliance with section 8

of The Homesteads Act, 1989; or

(c) the public trustee endorses his or her consent on the instrument on behalf of the infant or mentally incompetent non-owning spouse.

"(2) The public trustee may endorse his or her consent pursuant to clause (1)(c) notwithstanding that the public trustee is also the committee for the owning spouse".

# Coming into force
