CHAPTER 22

An Act to amend The Local Government Election Act

(Assented to June 22, 1990)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title¹ This Act may be cited as The Local Government Election Amendment Act, 1990.

2 Subsection 117(1) of The Local Government Election Act is amended by adding the following clause after clause (b):

- "(c) where a vote is to be taken with respect to two or more bylaws or proposed bylaws pursuant to section 88.1 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, the ballot shall contain:
- (i) a question whether the electors are in favour or not of any of the bylaws or proposed bylaws being submitted to the electors; and
 - (ii) the bylaws or proposed bylaws or a statement of their objects, as the case requires, in a manner that indicates the elector may indicate his or her approval with respect to one bylaw or proposed bylaw only".

Coming into force³ This Act comes into force on the day of assent but is retroactive and is deemed to have been in force on and from August 1, 1989.
