CHAPTER 6

An Act to amend The Medical Profession Act, 1981

(Assented to December 22, 1991)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title **1 This Act may be cited as The Medical Profession Amendment Act, 1991.**

2 The Medical Profession Act, 1981 is amended in the manner set forth in this Act.

Section 6 amended **3 Subsection 6(2) is amended:**

(a) by adding “, permits” after “licences” in clause (a);

(b) by repealing clause (b) and substituting the following clause:

“(b) prescribing classes of licences and permits and governing the requirements and qualifications for the issuing of licences and permits or any class or classes of licences or permits and prescribing the terms and conditions of them”;

(c) by adding “and permits” after “licences” wherever it appears in clause (s); and

(d) by adding “or permits” after “licences” in clause (u).

Section 30.1 amended

4 Section 30.1 is amended by striking out “should be restricted, the council may issue a licence to that person” and substituting “or a permit under section 31 should be restricted, the council may issue a licence or permit to that person”.

Section 31 amended **5 Subsection 31(2) is repealed and the following subsection substituted:**

“(2) A permit issued pursuant to subsection (1) authorizes the person named in the permit to practise in accordance with the bylaws of the council”.

Coming into force **6 This Act or any provision of this Act comes into force on a day or days to be fixed by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor.**
