CHAPTER 6

An Act to amend *The Occupational Therapists Act, 1997*

(Assented to May 27, 2003)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Occupational Therapists Amendment Act, 2003*.

S.S. 1997, c.O-1.11 amended

2 *The Occupational Therapists Act, 1997* is amended in the manner set forth in this Act.

Section 14 amended

3 Subsection 14(2) is amended:

(a) in clause (h) by striking out “approving” and substituting “prescribing”; and

(b) by repealing clause (i) and substituting the following:

“(i) respecting the occupational therapy education programs required to be successfully completed for the purposes of registration pursuant to this Act”.

Section 15 amended

4(1) Subsection 15(4) is repealed.

(2) Subsection 15(6) is repealed.

Section 16 amended

5(1) Subsection 16(5) is amended by striking out “or amendment” and substituting “, amendment or revocation”.

(2) Subsection 16(6) is repealed.

Section 19 amended

6 Clause 19(1)(c) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(c) has successfully completed an occupational therapy education program that is prescribed in the bylaws”.

Section 28 amended**7 Subsection 28(10) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(10) Subject to *The Saskatchewan Evidence Act* and section 58 of *The Regional Health Services Act*, and notwithstanding any other Act or the regulations made pursuant to any other Act, the records of any facility operated by a regional health authority or affiliate, within the meaning of *The Regional Health Services Act*, may be brought before the discipline committee, without special order, by writ of *subpoena duces tecum* issued pursuant to subsection (8) and served on the chief executive officer of the regional health authority or affiliate”.

Coming into force

8 This Act comes into force on proclamation.
