CHAPTER 43

An Act to amend *The Engineering and Geoscience Professions Act*

(Assented to June 27, 2000)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short title

1 This Act may be cited as *The Engineering and Geoscience Professions Amendment Act, 2000*.

2 *The Engineering and Geoscience Professions Act* is amended in the manner set forth in this Act.

Section 2 amended

3(1) Clause 2(1)(m) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(m) **‘practice of professional engineering’** means any act of planning, designing, composing, measuring, evaluating, inspecting, advising, reporting, directing or supervising, or managing any of the foregoing, that requires the application of engineering principles and that concerns the safeguarding of life, health, property, economic interests, the public interest or the environment”.

(2) Subsection 2(2) is repealed.

Section 20 amended

4 The following subsection is added after subsection 20(1):

“(1.1) Notwithstanding clause (1)(d), the council may register as a member a person who is a member in good standing, as a professional engineer or geoscientist, of any association of engineers or geoscientists in another jurisdiction within Canada if that association is recognized by the council as being comparable to the association”.

Section 28 amended

5(1) Section 28 is amended by striking out “Nothing” and substituting “Subject to subsection (2), nothing”.

(2) Section 28 is amended:

(a) by renumbering it as subsection 28(1); and

(b) by adding the following subsection after subsection 28(1):

“(2) Subsection (1) applies only if a person mentioned in that subsection does not practise as a professional engineer or professional geoscientist”.

Coming into force

6 This Act comes into force on assent.
