The Education Act

ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES OF SCHOOL DIVISIONS

No. 28/95. Pursuant to the power vested in me by subsection 27(1) of *The Education Act*, and in compliance with section 360 of the said Act, I hereby order that the boundaries of the following school divisions be altered, effective July 1, 1995, in the manner set forth herein:

Sub-division No. 4 of the Leader School Division No. 24 of Saskatchewan—

adding thereto:

in Township 23, in Range 25, west of the Third Meridian:
the south-east quarter of Section 36.

Sub-division No. 1 of the Kindersley School Division No. 34 of Saskatchewan—

taking therefrom:

in Township 23, in Range 25, west of the Third Meridian:
the south-east quarter of Section 36.

I further order, pursuant to subsection 118(1) of *The Education Act*, that tax arrears on the aforementioned land shall be payable to the school division from which the land was withdrawn, and further, that all taxes owing or already paid for the current year shall be apportioned between the two school divisions in a manner agreed upon by the respective boards of education.

The Oil and Gas Conservation Act

SPACING AREA "C"

MRO 543/95. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, MRO 57/84 A 45, dated April 24, 1984, and MRO 58/84 A 46, dated April 24, 1984, are rescinded and the following area is designated and identified as Spacing Area "C":

Lands lying west of the Third Meridian:

in Townships 1 to 6, in Ranges 18 to 22: all Sections;
in Townships 7 to 10, in Ranges 17 to 22: all Sections;
in Townships 11 to 19, in Ranges 16 to 20: all Sections;
in Township 12, in Range 15: Sections 19 to 36;
in Townships 13 to 19, in Range 15: all Sections.

Within this area, the provisions in the following schedule shall apply to the drilling of and production of oil and gas from vertical oil wells completed in the Cantuar Sand, Roseray Sand and Shaunavon Formation, unless otherwise ordered by the minister, effective August 1, 1995.

Schedule

1 The drainage unit shall be comprised of two legal subdivisions in a Section grouped as follows:

legal subdivisions 1 and 2; 3 and 4; 5 and 6; 7 and 8; 9 and 10; 11 and 12; 13 and 14; 15 and 16.

2 Within a drainage unit, the sides of the target area shall be located as follows:

(a) One hundred metres from and parallel to the corresponding sides of the even or odd legal subdivision, following the pattern established by existing oil wells. If the well is located outside a square area of nine Sections, centered on a Section that contains an oil well, the target area shall be 100 metres from and parallel to the corresponding sides of either legal subdivision.

(b) A well drilled adjacent to an established pool shall be located on the same pattern as that of the pool provided it falls within a square area of nine Sections centered on the Section containing a well in the pool.

3 If a well is not completed in the target area, the Minister may reduce the area used as a factor in determining the MARP.

DELTA WEST UPPER SHAUNAVON POOL

MRO 555/95 PB 36. Pursuant to section 13 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, the following area is designated and identified as an oil and gas pool named the "Delta West Upper Shaunavon Pool", effective August 1, 1995:

Lands in Township 15, in Range 20, west of the Third Meridian:
Section 10

MRO 556/95 PO 26. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, the following provisions shall apply to the drilling of, and the production of oil and gas from, vertical oil wells in the Delta West Upper Shaunavon Pool, effective August 1, 1995:

1 The drainage unit shall be comprised of one legal subdivision.

2 Within a drainage unit, the sides of the target area shall be 100 m from and parallel to the corresponding sides of the legal subdivision.

3 The MARP shall be multiplied by a factor of 2.0. If a well is not completed within the target area, the minister may reduce the area used as a factor in determining the MARP.

4(a) For the first well drilled in each Section, the operator shall submit samples of the interval from the top of the Second White Specks to total depth.

(b) For all subsequent wells drilled in each Section, the operator shall submit samples from the top of the Mississippian to total depth if such wells are intended to be drilled below the top of the Mississippian System.

5 As a minimum requirement, the operator shall run logs to determine the resistivity, spontaneous potential, porosity and gamma ray spectra from total depth to surface casing shoe for each well drilled.

EXTRACTS FROM THE RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF SASKATCHEWAN RELATING TO PRIVATE BILLS

PETITIONS

11(1) A petition to the Assembly may be presented by a Member at any time during the sitting of the Assembly by filing the same with the Clerk. . . .

(6) Petitions may be either written or printed; provided always that when there are three or more petitioners, the signatures of at least three petitioners shall be subscribed on the sheet containing the prayer of the petition. . . .

(9) No petition can be received which prays for any expenditure, grant or charge on the public revenue, whether payable out of the Consolidated Fund or out of moneys to be provided by the Assembly.

NOTE — *A form of Petition can be obtained on application to the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.*

PRIVATE BILLS

59(1) All petitions for Private Bills shall be in duplicate and shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly not later than the twentieth sitting day of the Session.

(2) No petition for any Private Bill shall be received by the Assembly if presented after the first 25 sitting days of the Session.

(3) No Private Bill may be introduced in the Assembly after the first 30 sitting days of the Session.

60(1) Every applicant for a Private Bill shall deposit with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the Petition for the same, two copies of the Bill, with marginal notes inserted, and an accepted cheque payable to the Minister of Finance for the sum of \$250, if the said Bill does not exceed 10 pages, and \$15 additional for each page over that number; 450 words shall be held to constitute a page.

(2) In the case of a Bill incorporating a company, a receipt from the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies for any statutory fees required shall also be deposited with the Clerk.

61 No remittance of a deposit on account of a Private Bill or any portion thereof shall be ordered by the Assembly unless the same has been recommended by the Committee charged with its consideration, or unless the Bill has been withdrawn, rejected or not reported upon, in which case the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the deposit received before making such remittance. . . .

63(1) All petitions to the Legislature for Private Bills of any nature whatsoever shall require a notice clearly and distinctly specifying the nature and object of the application and where the same refers to any proposed work, indicating generally the location of the work, and signed by and on behalf of the petitioners, with the address of the party signing the same; and when the petition is for an Act of Incorporation the name of the proposed company shall be stated in the notice.

(2) Such notice shall be published prior to the filing of the petition with the Clerk of the Assembly as required in subrule 59(1) in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and four consecutive issues of a newspaper, published in English and having circulation in the locality affected.

(3) A copy of the notice with a statutory declaration of the several publications of advertisement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the Petition and Bill. . . .

64(2) Every Bill for an Act of Incorporation, where a form of Model Bill has been adopted, shall be drawn in accordance with such Model Bill, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Assembly. Any provisions contained in any such Bill which are not in accord with the Model Bill shall be inserted between brackets and shall be so printed. . . .

67 When any Bill for confirming any agreement is filed with the Clerk of the Assembly, a true copy of such agreement must be attached to it.

COMMITTEE RULING

In cases where the proposed Bill provides that the property to be used or occupied by the petitioner be exempt from taxation, either in whole or in part, the petitioner must file with the Clerk of the Assembly, along with the petition, a written statement from the local municipal authority in which the said property is situated approving the intent of the provisions of the proposed Bill which provide for the exemption from taxation.

The name of the Member who is to present the Petition and Private Bill must be furnished to the Clerk of the Assembly at the time of filing the Petition. Such Member should not, of course, be a member of the Cabinet.
