## DIRECTOR'S ORDER

### **Saskatchewan Fishery Regulations, 1995**

(SOR/95-233)

DIRECTOR'S ORDER 1995-2  
VARYING CLOSE TIMES TO ALL FISHING

WHEREAS the Director of Fisheries, Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management, has been designated by the Minister responsible for the administration of *The Fisheries Act (Saskatchewan), 1994*, as a "Director" for the purposes of the *Saskatchewan Fishery Regulations, 1995* ("the regulations");

AND WHEREAS the federal regulations provide that no person shall fish or catch and retain any species of fish in any water within the province during the close time beginning on April 16 and ending on April 18 ("close time");

AND WHEREAS the Director may, by order, vary and close time in respect of any portion of waters within the province;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to section 8 of the regulations, the close time is hereby varied in respect of the portions of the following waters within the province and for the following time periods:

I further order, pursuant to subsection 118(1) of *The Education Act*, that tax arrears on the aforementioned land shall be payable to the board of education of the school division from which the land was withdrawn, and further, that all taxes owing or already paid for the current year shall be apportioned between the two school divisions in a manner agreed upon by the respective boards of education.
