### *The Education Act*

#### DISESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHOOL DIVISION AND ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES OF SCHOOL DIVISIONS

No. 77/96. Subject to the powers vested in me by subsection 27(1) and clauses 27(2)(a) and (b) of *The Education Act* and, in accordance with the provisions of clause 27(2.1)(b), subsections 31(1) and (3), sections 32, 118 and 360 of the said Act and subsections 6(1), 11(2), 12(2), section 16 and clause 145(1)(b) of *The Local Government Election Act*,

And, having received the approval of the Saskatchewan Municipal Board regarding the arrangements made to satisfy the existing financial obligations and other related matters of the Blaine Lake School Division No. 57 of Saskatchewan, in accordance with subsection 31(2) of *The Education Act*, now therefore I, Pat Atkinson, Minister of Education, hereby order as follows, effective January 1, 1997:

**1** that the Blaine Lake School Division No. 57 of Saskatchewan be disestablished;

**2** that the number of members comprising the Board of Education of the Saskatchewan Valley School Division No. 49 of Saskatchewan be increased to ten and further, that Sub-divisions Nos. 9 and 10 be established in the said School Division consisting of the following lands transferred from the jurisdiction of the Blaine Lake School Division No. 57 of Saskatchewan;

#### *Sub-division No. 9:*

in Township 45, in Range 4: those portions of Sections 15 to 17 inclusive lying north and west of the North Saskatchewan River, Sections 18 to 21 inclusive, those portions of Sections 22, 23 and 26 lying north and west of the said River, Sections 27 to 34 inclusive, those portions of Sections 35 and 36 lying north and west of the said River;

in Township 45, in Range 5: Sections 25 to 36 inclusive;

in Township 47, in Range 4: Sections 1 to 11 inclusive, the south half and north-east quarter of Section 14, Sections 15 to 18 inclusive, the south-west quarter of Section 19;

in Township 47, in Range 5: Sections 1 to 24, 26 to 35, all inclusive, the south half and north-east quarter of Section 36;

in Township 47, in Range 6: Sections 1 to 5, 8 to 36, all inclusive, that portion of Section 7 not included within the boundaries of the Muskeg Lake Indian Reserve No. 102;

in Township 47, in Range 7: Sections 4 to 9 inclusive, those portions of Sections 10 to 12 inclusive not included within the boundaries of the Muskeg Lake Indian Reserve No. 102, Sections 13 to 36 inclusive;

in Township 47, in Range 8: Sections 1 to 36 inclusive;

in Township 48, in Range 5: the south-east quarter of Section 1;

in Township 44, in Range 7: Sections 1 to 36 inclusive;

in Township 44, in Range 8: Sections 1 to 36 inclusive;

in Township 44, in Range 9: the east half of Section 12;

**3** (a) that an additional sub-division be established in the Saskatchewan Valley School Division No. 49 of Saskatchewan, to be known as Subdivision No. 11, comprising the Muskeg Lake Indian Reserve No. 102;

(b) that the secretary-treasurer of the Saskatchewan Valley School Division No. 49 of Saskatchewan shall cause to be delivered on or before November 28, 1996, at least two copies of the Nomination Paper and Candidate's Acceptance Form to the Chief of the Council of the Muskeg Lake Indian Reserve No. 102, with December 11, 1996 being the final date for the receipt of nominations by the returning officer.

(c) that, if more than one person is nominated, an election shall be held on the Muskeg Lake Indian Reserve No. 102, as Sub-division No. 11, on January 8, 1997, at a place designated by the Chief of the Council of the said Indian Reserve and that the said election be conducted in accordance with the provisions of *The Local Government Election Act*.

**4** that the number of members comprising the Board of Education of the Battleford School Division No. 58 of Saskatchewan be increased to eight and further, that Sub-division No. 8 be established in the said School Division consisting of the following lands transferred from the jurisdiction of the Blaine Lake School Division No. 57 of Saskatchewan:

in Township 41, in Range 10: the north-east quarter of Section 31;

in Township 42, in Range 8: Sections 7, 18, 19, those portions of Sections 30 and 31 not covered by the waters of Redberry Lake;

in Township 45, in Range 9: Sections 1 to 12, 14 to 23, 26 to 35, all inclusive;

in Township 45, Range 10: Sections 1 to 5 inclusive, the east half of Section 6, Sections 7 to 18, 22 to 27, all inclusive;

in Township 46, in Range 9: Sections 2 to 11, 14 to 23, 26 to 35, all inclusive;

all West of the Third Meridian.

**5** that the members to represent Sub-division Nos. 9 and 10 in the Saskatchewan Valley School Division No. 49 of Saskatchewan and Subdivision No. 8 in the Battleford School Division No. 58 of Saskatchewan be elected in by-elections on January 8, 1997, with Nomination Day being on December 11, 1996, and that such by-elections be conducted in accordance with the provisions of *The Local Government Election Act*;
