The Urban Municipality Act, 1984
[sections 13, 14 and 24]

ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES — TOWN OF BIENFAIT

1 Sections 13, 14 and 24 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* provide, in part, as follows:

13(1) In this section, “council” means:

(a) the council of an urban municipality that intends to apply for an alteration of its boundaries...

(7) The council may make an application for the alteration of its boundaries... in the form prescribed by the minister and shall submit:

(a) an application for the alteration of boundaries to:

(ii) the Saskatchewan Municipal Board if all other municipalities affected by the proposed alteration do not provide the council with the complementary resolutions mentioned in clause (e);

together with:

(c) a map showing in detail the proposed alteration in boundaries... and a brief explanation of the reasons for the proposal;

(d) a certified copy of a resolution of the council requesting the proposed alteration ... ;

(e) ... a certified copy of a complementary resolution of the council of each municipality affected by the proposed alteration;

(f) ... ; and

(g) a written summary of any public meeting held... and a copy of each written submission respecting the proposed alteration... received by the council.

14(1) ... the minister may, subject to any terms and conditions that he considers appropriate, by order:

(a) alter the boundaries of any urban municipality by:

(i) adding territory that shares common boundary with the urban municipality to that urban municipality;

(b) alter the boundaries of any other municipality affected by an order made pursuant to clause (a) so that they correspond to that order.

(2) The Minister shall make an order pursuant to subsection (1) if the Saskatchewan Municipal Board approves an application submitted to it pursuant to subclause 13(7)(a)(ii).

24 When making an order pursuant to this part that results in the alteration of the boundaries of an urban municipality, the minister, shall:

(a) describe the actual alteration of the boundaries of the urban municipality; and

(b) describe the new boundaries of the urban municipality...

2 The Council of the Town of Bienfait has submitted an application for an alteration of its boundaries to the Saskatchewan Municipal Board in the form prescribed by the Minister together with:

(a) a map showing in detail the proposed alteration of boundaries which involves withdrawing territory from the Rural Municipality of Coalfields No. 4 for the purpose of including lands to be used for the development of a municipal landfill into the boundaries of the Town of Bienfait; and

(b) a certified copy of a resolution of the Council of the Town of Bienfait requesting the proposed alteration.

3 The Town of Bienfait applied to the Saskatchewan Municipal Board, as the Council of the Rural Municipality of Coalfields No. 4 would not provide a complementary resolution. The Saskatchewan Municipal Board approved the application of the Town of Bienfait.

4 As a result of the above, it is desirable to alter the boundaries of the Town of Bienfait and the Rural Municipality of Coalfields No. 4.

The undersigned, therefore, issues an Order pursuant to sections 13, 14 and 24 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*:

(a) altering the boundaries of the Town of Bienfait by adding to the town and withdrawing from the Rural Municipality of Coalfields No. 4, territory adjoining the town and described in the attached “Schedule A”;

(b) altering the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Coalfields No. 4, so that they correspond to this Order; and

(c) confirming that the alteration shall take effect on and from August 1, 2001 and that the attached “Schedule B” is conclusively deemed to be the legal description of the boundaries of the Town of Bienfait; on the condition that the Town of Bienfait forthwith pay the Rural Municipality of Coalfields No. 4 the equivalent of five years municipal taxes, the base for such calculation being the 2001 assessment and mill rate of the Rural Municipality of Coalfields No. 4.

The Physical Therapists Act

SASKATCHEWAN COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL THERAPISTS — REGULATORY BYLAWS

BYLAW III – MEETINGS OF THE COLLEGE

Section 2 – Special Meetings

1 Council may call a special meeting of the college as required at a time and place decided upon by the council.

2 The council shall call a special meeting of the college on the written request of at least 10 percent of voting members.

BYLAW X – STATUTORY COMMITTEES

Section 1 – Statutory Committees

The statutory committees of the college shall be:

- (a) the professional conduct committee; and
- (b) the discipline committee.

Section 2 – Professional Conduct Committee

1 The professional conduct committee shall be established as per section 24 of the Act and shall conduct its affairs as set out in the Act.

2 In the event of a conflict of interest, the involved member of the Professional Conduct Committee will step down, and the council may appoint a replacement to deal with the specific complaint.

3 The committee shall notify, in writing, the member who is the subject of a report or allegation that a report or allegation has been received and ask for a written response.

4 The committee shall notify, in writing, the person who made the report or allegation that the report or allegation will be reviewed.

5 The committee may take appropriate action including:

- (a) resolution of the matter with the consent of the complainant and the member who is the subject of the investigation;
- (b) request any person to answer any questions and to produce any records, notes, photographs, x-rays, films, books, papers, or any other documents or things in the person's possession or under their control that are or may be relevant to the report or conduct to be investigated; and
- (c) with the consent of the person producing them, copy and keep copies of any of the documents or things that are produced under clause (b).

6 In the case where the allegation is dismissed, the committee shall notify any individual as to the outcome of the investigation as the committee deems appropriate.

Section 3 – Discipline Committee

1 The discipline committee shall be established in section 27 of the Act and shall conduct its affairs as set out in the Act.

2 In the event of a conflict of interest, the involved member of the discipline committee shall step down, and the council may appoint a replacement to deal with the specific hearing.

3 Without limiting the generality of section 22 and 23 of the Act, the committee may find a physical therapist guilty of professional incompetence and/or professional misconduct who:

- (a) abused a client physically, sexually, verbally or psychologically;
- (b) knowingly endangered the safety of a client;
- (c) engaged in the practice of physical therapy when the ability to perform any act in such practice is impaired by alcohol or drugs.
- (d) influenced a client to change the client's last will and testament;
- (e) wrongfully abandoned a client;
- (f) misappropriated property belonging to a client, employer or fellow employee;
- (g) failed to exercise discretion with respect to the disclosure of confidential information about a client;
- (h) failed to maintain, or falsified any client record;
- (i) failed to inform an employer of the physical therapist's inability to accept specific responsibility in areas where special training is required or where the physical therapist does not feel competent to function without supervision;
- (j) failed to report the incompetence or misconduct of a member or colleague;
- (k) failed to comply with the *Code of Ethics* of the college and failed to comply with established standards of practice;
- (l) failed without reasonable cause to respond to inquiries from the college regarding alleged professional misconduct or professional incompetence;
- (m) conspired to participate in any act of misconduct or counselled a participant in any act of misconduct;
- (n) obtained registration by misrepresentation or fraud; and/or
- (o) contravened any provision of the Act or these bylaws.

4 Where the committee determines that the person is not guilty of professional incompetence and/or professional misconduct, written notice that the complaint has been dismissed shall be provided to:

- (a) the person who was the subject of the report;
- (b) the person who made the report; and
- (c) any other persons deemed necessary by the committee.

5 Findings of guilt shall be matters of public interest and reported in college publications. Findings of guilt that affect licensure shall be made to the member's current employer.

BYLAW XI – CONFLICT OF INTEREST

1 A conflict of interest may involve any of the following:

- (a) elected members of council;
- (b) members appointed to serve as delegates, committee members or committee chairs; and
- (c) employees of the college acting in an official capacity.

2 Members serving in an official capacity as council members, committee members or representatives of the college shall declare a conflict of interest in matters under discussion, business of the college or in decisions taken in which they have a vested interest.

3 It shall be the responsibility of the presiding officer to ensure that members identifying a conflict of interest shall leave the meeting during considerations of the pertinent issue and the secretary of the meeting shall record the departure of the member.

4 Members who represent the college shall not assume a position if a conflict of interest is identified.

5 A conflict of interest may be defined as, but is not limited to the following:

(a) where the member is involved in negotiating wages and/or employment contracts, or completing performance appraisals for college staff who may be related to that member;

(b) where the member is involved in determining/reviewing credentials and registration/licensing eligibility for an applicant or another member who may be related to that member;

(c) where the member is involved in the investigation and/or discipline process affecting another member who may be related to that member; and

(d) where the member or family member might personally or financially benefit from decisions or information gained from involvement on council or committees.

BYLAW XII – MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 – Categories of Membership

1 Membership in the college shall consist of the following categories:

- (a) practicing membership;
- (b) restricted licence membership;
- (c) non-practicing membership;
- (d) life membership; and
- (e) honorary membership.

2 The membership year shall be April 1 to March 31.

Section 2 – Practicing Membership

1 Practicing membership in the college shall be:

(a) limited to a physical therapist to whom a licence to practice physical therapy is issued by the college in accordance with the Act; and

(b) granted upon completion of the prescribed application form and payment of the fees set by the college.

2 Practicing membership entitles a person to the following privileges:

- (a) to practice physical therapy in Saskatchewan;
- (b) to vote and hold office in the college;
- (c) to have voice and vote at the annual and special meetings of the college;
- (d) to be appointed to committees of the college;
- (e) to receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and
- (f) to receive the publications of the college.

3 Practicing membership carries obligations including, but not limited to the following:

- (a) to adhere to the college's *Code of Ethics*;
- (b) to use established physical therapy standards as a guide for the practice of physical therapy; and
- (c) to notify the registrar of any change in name, address and/or employment status.

Section 3 – Restricted Licence Membership

1 Restricted licence membership in the college shall be:

(a) limited to a physical therapist to whom a restricted licence to practice physical therapy is issued by the college, in accordance with the Act; and

(b) granted upon completion of the prescribed application form and payment of the fees set by the college.

2 Restricted licence membership entitles a person to the following privileges:

(a) to practice physical therapy subject to the restrictions imposed and for the period specified in a restricted licence;

(b) to have voice, but no vote, at the annual and special meetings of the college;

(c) to be appointed to committees of the college;

(d) to receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and

(e) to receive the publications of the college.

3 Restricted licence membership carries obligations including, but not limited to, the following:

(a) to adhere to the college's *Code of Ethics*;

(b) to use established physical therapy standards as a guide for the practice of physical therapy; and

(c) to notify the registrar of any change in name, address and/or employment status.

Section 4 – Non-practicing Membership

1 Non-practicing membership in the college shall be:

(a) limited to a physical therapist who:

(i) is eligible for registration as a practicing member in accordance with subsection 19(1) of the Act; and

(ii) is not currently practicing physical therapy in Saskatchewan;

(b) granted upon completion of the prescribed application form and payment of the fees set by the college.

2 Non-practicing membership entitles a person to the following privileges:

(a) to have voice, but no vote, at the annual and special meetings of the college;

(b) to be appointed to committees of the college;

(c) to receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and

(d) to receive the publications of the college.

Section 5 – Life Membership

1 Life membership in the college shall be:

(a) limited to former practicing members of the college who are retired from the practice of physical therapy; and

(b) granted by the council in recognition of outstanding service to physical therapy in Saskatchewan.

2 Life membership entitles a person to the following privileges without payment of fees:

(a) to have voice, but no vote, at the annual and special meetings of the college;

(b) to be appointed to committees of the college;

(c) to receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and

(d) to receive the publications of the college.

Section 6 – Honorary Membership

1 Honorary membership in the college shall be:

(a) limited to persons who are not physical therapists or are physical therapists registered outside Saskatchewan; and

(b) granted by the council in recognition of distinguished service to the profession of physical therapy or for valuable assistance to physical therapy in Saskatchewan.

2 Honorary membership entitles a person to the following privileges without payment of fees:

(a) to have voice, but no vote, at the annual and special meetings of the college;

(b) to receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and

(c) to receive the publications of the college.

Section 7 – Change of Status

Non-practicing or restricted licence members may become practicing members of the college upon payment of the required fee and compliance with current bylaws and policies governing registration.

BYLAW XIII – REGISTRATION

Section 1 – Registrar

The registrar shall:

- (a) receive and evaluate applications for licences, restricted licences, registration, and memberships;
- (b) collect the prescribed fees;
- (c) issue licences, restricted licences and memberships;
- (d) maintain the register of members as required by subsection 18(1) of the Act; and
- (e) perform other such duties as determined by council.

Section 2 – Initial Registration as a Member

(1) The following persons making an application for registration may be registered as physical therapists upon submitting proof of qualifications and payment of the proper fees:

- (a) any person who is a graduate in physical therapy from a university in any province in Canada; or
- (b) any person who is registered in any province or territory and has no current restrictions to practice or disciplinary actions pending against that person; or
- (c) any person who has successfully completed the physiotherapy competency examination as prescribed by the Canadian Alliance of Physiotherapy Regulators.

(2) Any other person who is a graduate from a university, college or school in any other country may be entitled to be registered as a physical therapist if the council is satisfied that:

- (a) the academic standards and curriculum of instruction fixed by such university, college or school for the teaching of physical therapy are deemed, by council, to be at least equivalent to those of a Canadian University physical therapy program; and
- (b) the language fluency requirement as established by the Canadian Alliance of Physiotherapy Regulators has been met; and
- (c) there are no current restrictions to practice or disciplinary actions pending against that person.

(3) Registration of an applicant in the college as a member may be granted by the registrar, pending submission of the application to the council at the next regular meeting. Any reversal of eligibility by the council is not retroactive.

Section 3 – Refusal of Registration

(1) When the council refuses an application for registration, the applicant shall be so informed by registered mail within seven days of the refusal. Such an applicant shall be advised of the right to request reconsideration in accordance with subsection (2) below.

(2) Any applicant whose registration has been refused by the council may have the application reconsidered by making a request, stating the reasons, in writing, not more than thirty days after receipt of notification of the refusal. The council shall there upon reconsider such application and either order the applicant's registration or refuse the application. The decision of the council shall be transmitted to the applicant by registered mail within seven days from the date of the decision and such decision shall be final.

Section 4 – Transition Period

Any person who is a graduate from a university, college or school in any other country, and who has initiated the process of registration prior to the date of approval of these bylaws, shall be required to complete the registration process as outlined in bylaws which existed prior to the date of approval of these bylaws.

BYLAW XIV – LICENCE TO PRACTICE

Section 1 – Proof of Practice

(1) Every physical therapist shall, before practicing physical therapy in Saskatchewan, apply for and obtain a licence.

(2) An applicant who is registered shall submit proof of number of practice hours, dates and places of practice as determined by the council.

(3) An applicant for a licence to practice must provide proof, satisfactory to Council, of professional liability insurance for an amount not less than Five Million dollars (\$5 Million) on any one client or Five Million dollars (\$5 Million) maximum for the policy year.

(4) Subject to registration and the payment of the appropriate fees, completion of the application form and otherwise complying with these bylaws, every person who is registered with the college shall be entitled to receive a licence to practice physical therapy in the province of Saskatchewan under the corporate seal of the college, signed by the registrar.

Section 2 – Licence to Practice Physical Therapy

(1) A licence to practice physical therapy, which shall cover the period from the date of issue to March 31 subsequent, may be granted to individuals who have registered pursuant to Bylaw XIII, subsection 2(1) and have:

- (a) successfully completed a physical therapy program in Canada within four years immediately preceding the date of application; or
- (b) successfully completed a re-entry program approved by the college within four years immediately preceding the date of application; or
- (c) completed 1200 hours of physical therapy practice anywhere in the world within the five year period immediately preceding the date of application; and
- (d) have provided proof of professional liability insurance for the minimum amount as set in Bylaw XIV, subsection 1(3).

(2) The registrar may issue a licence to practice physical therapy pending ratification by the council.

Section 3 – Restricted Licence

(1) A restricted licence may be granted to individuals who have registered but also who can only practice physical therapy under well-defined conditions or limitations imposed by council, and have provided proof of professional liability insurance for the minimum amount as set in Bylaw XIV, subsection 1(3).

(2) Restricted licences may be issued to:

- (a) a person who is licensed to practice as a physical therapist in another country, or province or territory of Canada and who is an instructor in a continuing education course during which time that person will treat clients;
- (b) physical therapists who by virtue of disciplinary proceedings by the college have restrictions placed upon their practice;
- (c) those persons undertaking a period of supervised practice in physical therapy pursuant to Bylaw XIV, section 6;
- (d) those persons registered pursuant to Bylaw XIII, subsection 2(2).

(3) A restricted licence issued according to clause 3(2)(d) shall be for up to 18 months, during which time the person must successfully complete the physiotherapy national examination.

(4) A physical therapist who is visiting the Province of Saskatchewan to provide physical therapy to members of any athletic or sports teams which are participating in an event in this province must be registered and obtain a restricted licence.

(5) A physical therapist who is accompanying an athlete or team from another country, province or territory and who will only provide physical therapy to that athlete or team does not require a restricted licence.

(6) The registrar may issue a restricted licence pending ratification by the council.

(7) The restricted licence so issued shall state the limitations imposed by council on practice by this bylaw.

(8) With the exception of subsection 3(3), council, in each case, shall determine the duration of the restricted licence. It may be renewed at the discretion of council.

Section 4 – Renewal of Licence

(1) Subject to the payment of the appropriate fees and completion of the annual renewal form, every licence issued to a physical therapist shall have a renewal date of April 1 each year. All applicants must have met the conditions outlined in Bylaw XIV, subsection 2(1).

(2) A late fee is payable by a physical therapist whose application for renewal of a licence to practice is not received by the registrar at the end of designated business hours of the last working day on or before March 31.

(3) Where no application has been received by the registrar for the renewal of a licence to practice at the end of designated business hours of the last working day on or before March 31, the registrar shall forward a second renewal notice by registered mail. The second notice shall include a copy of the bylaws related to the renewal of a licence to practice.

Section 5 – Loss of Licence

(1) A physical therapist who has failed to renew a licence to practice by April 30 of the current year shall lose the licence.

(2) Any member who loses a licence to practice, and believes there is good reason why the licence should not be lost, may appeal in writing to the council by May 31 of the current year.

Section 6 – Re-entry after Absence from Practice

(1) After five years of absence from the practice of physical therapy, the applicant shall be required to successfully complete the physiotherapy competency exam and shall be required to undergo a period of supervised practice in accordance with council policy.

(2) A person who has worked in the practice of physical therapy, but has not met the requirements of a minimum of 1200 hours of practice during the five years prior to application for a licence, shall be required to successfully undertake a period of supervised practice and may be required to successfully complete the physiotherapy competency examination.

(3) A person shall be registered and obtain a restricted licence prior to beginning a period of supervised practice.

(4) The supervised practice shall take place:

- (a) under the direction of a licenced physical therapist(s) approved by the council; and
- (b) in a physical therapy facility or facilities approved by the council.

(5) The number of hours of supervised practice required shall be determined as set out in the college's policy and procedure for re-entry.

(6) The council shall receive a satisfactory report on the applicant's performance, given by the supervisor(s), before a licence to practice is issued.

BYLAW XVI – STANDARDS

Section 1 – Code of Ethics and Rules of Conduct

1 Physical therapists shall respect the client's rights, dignity, needs, and values.

2 Physical therapists may not refuse care to any client on grounds of race, religion, ethnic or national origin, age, sex, sexual orientation, social or health status.

3 Physical therapists must respect the clients or surrogate's rights to be informed about the effects of treatment and inherent risks.

4 Physical therapists must give clients or surrogates the opportunity to consent or decline treatment or alterations in the treatment regime.

5 Physical therapists shall confine themselves to clinical diagnosis and management in those aspects of physical therapy in which they have been educated and which the profession recognizes.

6 Physical therapists shall assume full responsibility for all care they provide.

7 Physical therapists shall not treat clients when the medical diagnosis or clinical condition indicates that the commencement or continuation of physical therapy is not warranted or contraindicated.

8 Physical therapists shall request consultation with, or refer clients to, colleagues or members of other health professionals when, in the opinion of the physical therapist, such action is in the best interest of the client.

9 Physical therapists shall document the client's history and relevant subjective information, the physical therapist's objective findings, clinical diagnosis, treatment plan and procedures, explanation to the client, progress notes and discharge summary.

10 Physical therapists shall respect all client information as confidential. Such information shall not be communicated to any person without the consent of the client or surrogate except when required by law.

11 Physical therapists, with the client's or surrogate's consent, may delegate specific aspects of the care of the client to a person deemed by the physical therapist to be competent to carry out the care safely and effectively.

12 Physical therapists are responsible for all duties they delegate to personnel under their supervision.

13 Physical therapists shall recognize their responsibility to improve standards of health care.

14 Physical therapists shall comply with all laws and bylaws pertaining to the practice of physical therapy.

15 Physical therapists shall report to the appropriate authorities any member of the profession who appears to be incompetent or whose conduct while practising as a physical therapist appears to be unethical or illegal.

16 Where a direct fee is charged, physical therapists shall inform clients, in advance, of the fee that will be commensurate with the service provided.

17 Physical therapists shall conduct themselves in such a manner as to merit the respect of the society for the profession and its members.

18 Physical therapists shall ensure their professional judgment and integrity are not compromised by motives of profit.

19 Physical therapists shall maintain an optimum standard of practice by exercising competent professional judgment and by continually striving to improve knowledge and professional skills.

Section 2 – Sexual Abuse

For the purpose of Bylaw X, clause 3(a), sexual abuse includes, but is not limited to:

- (a) sexual intercourse or any other form of sexual activity between a client and a member;
- (b) touching of a sexual nature between a client and the member including, but not limited to:
 - (i) touching or massaging breasts or pelvic area, or any sexualized body part for any purpose other than that required for therapeutic evaluation or treatment;
 - (ii) kissing of a sexual nature;
- (c) behavior or remarks of a sexual nature between a client and member including, but not limited to:
 - (i) verbal or written comments, inappropriate procedures, gestures or expressions that are seductive or sexually demeaning to the client;
 - (ii) deliberately watching a client dress or undress except for the purpose of assessment; explanation must be made to the client as to why the member wishes to observe, and consent must be given;
 - (iii) failure to explain the relevance of a procedure involving the breast or pelvic area, and not receiving consent for the procedure;
 - (iv) subjecting a client to an examination of the breast or pelvic area in the presence of students or others without obtaining specific consent;
 - (v) questioning the client regarding the client's sexual performance, history, or orientation unless relevant to the assessment or treatment;
 - (vi) discussion of a client's sexual performance, history or orientation unless clinically relevant.

Section 3 – Physical Therapy Practice

When considering physical therapy scope of practice:

1 The college recognizes the Entry-Level Curriculum document of the Canadian University Physical Therapy Academic Council and the Canadian Physiotherapy Association as the approved curriculum for undergraduate Physical Therapy programs in Canada.

2 The college recognizes the *Competency Profile for the Entry Level Physiotherapist in Canada*, which identifies competencies which graduate physical therapists must be capable of demonstrating to be eligible for initial registration in Saskatchewan.

3 The practice of physical therapy is the use by a physical therapist of specific knowledge, skills and professional judgment to improve clients' functional independence and physical performance, manage physical impairments, disabilities and handicaps, and promote health and fitness.

Section 4 – Specialized Physical Therapy Procedures

1 Registered physical therapists may perform the following procedures only after successfully completing an educational program of specific theory and practice.

1.1 Acupuncture

(a) the college recognizes acupuncture as a physical therapy act;

(b) physical therapists wishing to practice acupuncture must successfully complete a post-graduate acupuncture-training program and provide proof of training to council. The standards and training program set out by the Acupuncture Foundation of Canada or any such equivalent program, approved by Council, is acceptable;

(c) physical therapists in the process of completing an approved formal acupuncture training program will use only those acupuncture procedures in which training has been completed.

1.2 Dry Needling

(a) the college recognizes dry needling as a physical therapy act;

(b) physical therapists wishing to practice dry needling must successfully complete a post-graduate dry needling program approved by Council, and provide proof of training to council for approval in order to be recognized as qualified to use this technique.

1.3 Manipulation

(a) the college recognizes spinal and peripheral manipulation as a physical therapy act. Manipulation is a high velocity, low amplitude thrust technique performed at the limit of available movement, the purpose of which is to restore mobility;

(b) physical therapists must practice manipulation within their level of knowledge, skill, professional judgment and competence to provide the standard of practice required by the College;

(c) physical therapists wishing to practice a spinal manipulation technique that is not taught in their undergraduate program, must successfully complete the post-graduate course requirements and examinations required by the Orthopedic Division of the Canadian Physiotherapy Association, or an equivalent standard, and must meet the Professional Standards of Practice of the College. Documentation of training and examination must be submitted to the College.

Section 5 – Advertising Standards

1 No physical therapist shall offer to guarantee a cure either verbally or in writing or by advertising or otherwise.

2 Advertising, promotion, and other marketing activities must be accurate and not capable of misleading the public either directly or indirectly through any medium or agent that:

(a) misrepresents facts;

(b) compares either directly, indirectly or by innuendo, the member's services or ability with that of any other practitioner or clinic, or promises or offers more effective service or better results than those available elsewhere;

(c) deprecates another member or clinic as to service, ability or fees;

(d) creates an unjustified expectation about the results the member can achieve;

(e) is made under any false or misleading guise, or takes advantage, either physically, emotionally, or financially of any patient, or uses coercion, duress, or harassment;

(f) is incompatible with the best interests of the public or members, or tends to harm the standing of the physical therapy profession generally;

(g) contains any testimonial or discloses the names of clients; or

(h) contains any reference to a specific brand of drug, device, or equipment.

3 A breach by any member of any of the provisions contained in the above subsection of this bylaw shall be deemed professional misconduct.

BYLAW XVII – REPEAL OF PREVIOUS BYLAWS

Any previous bylaws are repealed on the date these bylaws come into force, in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
