The Election Act, 1996
[section 9]

[O.C. 86/2006]
24 February 2006

Section 9 of *The Election Act, 1996* provides, as follows:

9(1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint a voter residing in Saskatchewan as the returning officer for the constituency in which the voter resides.

(2) If an Act is passed as contemplated by section 23 of *The Constituency Boundaries Act, 1993* establishing one or more new constituencies, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may, whether or not the Act is in force, appoint a voter residing in each new constituency as the returning officer for the new constituency.

Pursuant to section 9 of *The Election Act, 1996*, on the recommendation of the President of the Executive Council, the Lieutenant Governor in Council cancels the appointment of the returning officer for the following constituency, listed below in Schedule I, and appoints a returning officer to the following constituency, as listed below in Schedule II.
