Order No. 17/09. The Saskatchewan Canola Development Commission, pursuant to the provisions of *The Canola Development Plan Regulations* and *The Agri-Food Act, 2004*, hereby determines and orders as follows:

- 1 A request for levy refunds shall:
 - (a) be made in writing on a form that is provided by the Commission; and
 - (b) contain the following information:
 - (i) the producer's name;
 - (ii) the producer's mailing address and telephone number;
 - (iii) the producer's Canadian Wheat Board identification number, if applicable; and
 - (iv) any such other information as the Commission may require.
- 2 Requests for levy refunds received by the Commission at its head office within the regulated time period shall be considered by the Commission.
- 3 For each levy refund request, the producer will be granted a refund with respect to the levy in question if all refund requirements are met.
- 4 Order 08/02 – Refund of Check-offs is hereby wholly revoked.
- 5 This order will remain in effect for a period no longer than ten years from the date this order is approved by the Agri-Food Council.
