# ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES — BETWEEN THE RESORT VILLAGE OF NORTH GROVE AND THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN NO. 190

- 1 Pursuant to sections 53, 56, 57, 59, and 61 of *The Municipalities Act*, the Council of the Resort Village of North Grove has submitted an application to alter its boundaries to the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
- **2** Upon consideration of the application, the Minister is of the opinion that the municipalities affected will be viable entities following the alteration of boundaries. Therefore, the undersigned hereby orders, pursuant to sections 61, 62, and 63 of *The Municipalities Act*, that:
  - (a) the boundaries of the Resort Village of North Grove and the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190 be altered by withdrawing from the rural municipality and adding to the village the territory described in Schedule A;
  - (b) Schedule B is conclusively deemed to be the legal description of the boundary of the Resort Village of North Grove; and
  - (c) the alteration shall take effect on and from the date of this Order.

#### SCHEDULE A

The boundaries of the Resort Village of North Grove are altered by adding to the Village and withdrawing from the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190 the territory lying within:

Section 9, Township 20, Range 26, West of the Second Meridian and described as:

(a) that portion lying within a line commencing at the point of intersection between the north-eastern boundary of Daniel Dr. shown on Plan No. 85MJ13075 and the western boundary of the road allowance defining the eastern limit of the south-east quarter of Section 9, Township 20, Range 26, West of the Second Meridian, then northerly along the western boundary of the said road allowance a distance of 87.828 m, then north-easterly at an angle of 115°07'21" a distance of 77.865 m to the point of intersection with the north-eastern boundary of Daniel Dr. shown on Plan No. 85MJ13075, then south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of Daniel Dr. shown on Plan No. 85MJ13075 a distance of 147.904 m to the point of commencement.

Unless otherwise specified, the sections and portions of sections described in the above schedules include the adjoining south and west road allowances, intersections thereof and widenings thereto by plan of survey.

For description purposes, the land acquired by plan of survey for widening to an adjoining road allowance is deemed to be part of the road allowance.

The said plans of survey are of record with Information Services Corporation of Saskatchewan.

#### SCHEDULE B

The boundaries of the Resort Village of North Grove shall comprise the territory in the Province of Saskatchewan lying within Township 20, Range 26, West of the Second Meridian and described as:

- (1) the following portions of Section 9:
  - (a) that portion lying between the eastern boundary of the said section, the north-eastern boundaries of Daniel Dr. shown on Plans No. 85MJ13075 and No. 60MJ13805 and the waters of Buffalo Pound Lake;
  - (b) Lot 1, Block 7 shown on Plan No. 85MJ13075; and
  - (c) Blocks 2 to 4, Sunset Cres. and Maple Dr. shown on Plan No. 60MJ13805;
  - (d) that portion lying within a line commencing at the point of intersection between the north-eastern boundary of Daniel Dr. shown on Plan No. 85MJ13075 and the western boundary of the road allowance defining the eastern limit of the south-east quarter of Section 9, Township 20, Range 26, West of the Second Meridian, then northerly along the western boundary of the said road allowance a distance of 87.828 m, then north-easterly at an angle of 115°07'21" a distance of 77.865 m to the point of intersection with the north-eastern boundary of Daniel Dr. shown on Plan No. 85MJ13075, then south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of Daniel Dr. shown on Plan No. 85MJ13075 a distance of 147.904 m to the point of commencement;
- (2) the following portions of Section 16:
  - (a) that portion of the south-west quarter lying between the north-eastern boundaries of Daniel Dr. and Grace Cres. shown on Plan No. 60MJ13805 and the waters of Buffalo Pound Lake;
  - (b) that portion of the north-west quarter comprising:
    - (i) that part lying between the north-eastern boundary of Grace Cres. shown on Plan No. 60MJ13805 and the western boundary of Difley Dr. shown on Plan No. 87MJ16416 and lying south of the southern boundary of Block 5 shown on Plan No. 60MJ08944 and the easterly and westerly productions thereof;

- (ii) that part lying between the western boundary of Difley Dr. shown on Plan No. 87MJ16416, the south-western boundary of Daniel Dr. shown on Plan No. 60MJ08944 and the waters of Buffalo Pound Lake; and
- (iii) Blocks 1 to 5, Public Reserves R1 to R3, Brent Dr., Alice Cres., Daniel Dr. and Grace Cres. shown on Plan No. 60MJ08944;

#### THE OAT DEVELOPMENT PLAN REGULATIONS - SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

**Order No. 07/12.** The SASKATCHEWAN OAT DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, pursuant to the provisions of *The Oat Development Plan Regulations* and *The Agri-Food Act, 2004*, hereby determines and orders as follows:

- 1 The Commission may act as an agent for registered producers in matters relating to the Scientific Research and Experimental Development (SR&ED) Program.
- 2 All SR&ED transactions by the Commission will constitute a transaction made by registered producers.
- 3 The appropriate percentage of levy contributions will be considered as a payment directly from registered producers to the researchers and developers under the SR&ED.
- 4 The Commission will:
  - (a) ensure registered producers have a preferential right to exploit the results of the SR&ED;
  - (b) determine the SR&ED projects that will be funded each year by holding a vote at meetings of the Saskatchewan Oat Development Commission Board of Directors;
  - (c) file an SR&ED claim each year on behalf of their members within six months of their fiscal year end to assist registered producers in receiving their tax credit entitlements on a timely basis;
  - (d) in cases where registered producers cannot determine the SR&ED contribution, provide that information when possible;
  - (e) provide each registered producer with information identifying the percentage of the total levy that was used to fund SR&ED in the year; and
  - (f) advise registered producers in which province the SR&ED was performed.

**5** This Order will remain in effect for a period no longer than ten years from the date this Order is approved by the Agri-Food Council.

Order No. 07/12 is made pursuant to clause 8(1)(a) of *The Oat Development Plan Regulations* and shall be effective upon the date of this Order. By order of the Saskatchewan Oat Development Commission.

### The Chiropractic Act, 1994 [subsection 15(2)]

#### CHIROPRACTORS' ASSOCIATION OF SASKATCHEWAN — REGULATORY BYLAW AMENDMENTS

Pursuant to subsection 15(2) of *The Chiropractic Act, 1994*, the Regulatory Bylaws of the Chiropractor's Association of Saskatchewan are amended as follows:

#### Section 4(1)(e) is amended to read:

- "4(1) Subject to subsection 4(4), registration as a regular member shall be granted to a person who has not previously held a valid licence to practice chiropractic in any Province or Territory of Canada, upon the completion of the prescribed application form, including any prescribed statutory declaration, payment of the prescribed fees set out in the applicable administrative bylaw and production of evidence satisfactory to the board that the person:
  - (e) carries, or upon registration shall carry, professional liability protection on terms, including as to limits of coverage, satisfactory to the board;"

#### Section 4(2)(b) is amended to read:

- "4(2) Subject to subsection 4(4), any applicant to whom section 16 of these regulatory bylaws does not apply, and who previously held or still holds a valid licence to practice chiropractic in any Province or Territory of Canada, which licence was substantially equivalent to an annual licence to practice issued under and pursuant to the Act and these regulatory bylaws to a practicing regular member, may be registered as a practicing member, provided:
  - (b) the applicant carries, or upon registration shall carry, professional liability protection on terms, including as to limits of coverage, satisfactory to the board;"

#### Section 7(1)(c) is amended to read:
