RULES OF COURT/ RÈGLES DE PROCÉDURE

The Queen's Bench Act, 1998/Loi de 1998 sur la Cour du Banc de la Reine [section 28]

COURT OF QUEEN'S BENCH FOR SASKATCHEWAN

The Rules of the Court of Queen's Bench for Saskatchewan are amended, effective the 4th day of January, 2013, in the manner set out below:

1 The header titled "I EXECUTION GENERALLY" following "PART THIRTY EXECUTION" is struck out.

2 Rule 352 is repealed and the following substituted:

"Enforcing payment of money

352(1) Subject to subrules (2) and (3) and to rule 352.1, every person to whom any sum of money or any costs are payable under a judgment or order is entitled, as soon as the money or costs are payable, to enforce that judgment or order in any manner authorized by law.

(2) If the judgment or order mentioned in subrule (1) is for payment within a period mentioned in the judgment or order, a person may take any enforcement measure only after the expiration of that period.

(3) At or after the time of giving judgment or making an order, the Court may stay any enforcement measure until the time the Court considers fit.

“The Enforcement of Money Judgments Act applies

352.1 Notwithstanding any other rule, unless the court orders otherwise, a judgment governed by *The Enforcement of Money Judgments Act* must be enforced in accordance with the procedures established pursuant to that Act”.

3 Rule 353 is repealed.

4 Rules 357 to 361 are repealed.

5 Rules 368 and 369 are repealed.

6 Rule 373 is repealed and the following substituted:

“Recovery of land and costs

373 On any judgment or order for the recovery or delivery of possession of any land and costs:

(a) the judgment or order for the recovery or delivery of possession of the land may be enforced by issuance of a writ of possession; and

(b) the judgment or order for costs may, after being assessed, be enforced in accordance with the provisions of *The Enforcement of Money Judgments Act*”.

7 Rule 374 is repealed.

8 The header titled “II POUNDAGE, INTEREST, ETC.” following rule 378 is struck out.

9 Rules 379 to 382 are repealed.

10 Subrule 383(1) is amended by striking out “Any judgment creditor or party” and substituting “Any party”.

11 Part Thirty-Three is repealed.

12 Forms 37 and 38 are repealed.

RÈGLES DE PROCÉDURE COUR DU BANC DE LA REINE DE LA SASKATCHEWAN

Les Règles de la Cour du Banc de la Reine de la Saskatchewan sont modifiées à compter du 4 Janvier 2013, de la manière suivante :

1 L'intertitre «I Dispositions générales en matière d'exécution forcée» qui suit «PARTIE 30 EXÉCUTION FORCÉE» est supprimé.

2 La règle 352 est abrogée et remplacée par ce qui suit :

«Poursuite du paiement d'une somme

352(1) Sous réserve des paragraphes (2) et (3) et de la règle 352.1, la personne à qui des sommes ou des dépens sont dus en vertu d'un jugement ou d'une ordonnance a le droit, dès que ces sommes ou dépens sont exigibles, de recourir à tout moyen légal pour obtenir l'exécution du jugement ou de l'ordonnance.

(2) Si le jugement ou l'ordonnance mentionné au paragraphe (1) alloue un délai de paiement, la personne ne peut prendre des mesures d'exécution qu'après l'expiration de ce délai.

(3) Le tribunal peut, lors du prononcé du jugement ou de l'ordonnance ou ultérieurement, en suspendre les mesures d'exécution pour la durée qu'il estime indiquée.
