The Personal Property Security Act, 1993 Section 71

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Personal Property Security Amendment Regulations, 1996.*

2 *The Personal Property Security Regulations* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

Section 2 amended

- 3 The following subsection is added after subsection 2(2):
- "(3) For the purposes of subsection 4(1.1) and sections 4.1 and 4.2:
 - (a) **'recommencement of registry functions'** means the date set by the minister for the recommencement of any one or more registry functions after a suspension of registry functions;
 - (b) **'registration'** means a registration mentioned in subsection 4(1) and includes, where the context permits, a registration amended or renewed prior to the suspension of registry functions;
 - (c) **'suspension of registry functions'** means suspension of one or more functions of the registry pursuant to clause 42(5)(a), (b) or (c) of the Act".

New section 2.1

4 The following section is added after section 2:

"Extension of hours

- **2.1**(1) Notwithstanding section 36, the registry office is to be open to the public from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on November 9, 10 and 11, 1996.
- (2) Notwithstanding section 37, the electronic registry system is to be open to the public from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on November 9, 10 and 11, 1996".

Section 4 amended

5 The following subsection is added after subsection 4(1):

"(1.1) Notwithstanding subsection (1), where the actual date of expiry selected by the registrant for a registration occurs during a suspension of registry functions or within five days from the recommencement of registry functions, that registration remains effective for an additional 10 days from the recommencement of registry functions and expires at the end of the tenth day following the recommencement of registry functions".

New sections 4.1 and 4.2

6 The following sections are added after section 4:

"Extension of time period

4.1 Where, during a suspension of registry functions or within five days from the recommencement of registry functions, there is an expiration of a time period pursuant to the Act or these regulations for effecting any registration or for effecting any amendment to or discharge of a registration, that time period is extended for an additional 10 days from the recommencement of registry functions.

"Effect of registration during extended period

4.2 A registration or any amendment to or discharge of a registration that is effected during the extended time period set out in section 4.1 is deemed to have the same effect as if the registration or the amendment to or discharge of the registration was effected within the original time period set out in the Act or these regulations".

Coming into force

7 These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
