REVISED REGULATIONS OF SASKATCHEWAN

SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 99/2000

The Summary Offences Procedure Act, 1990

Sections 30 and 55

Order in Council 724/2000, dated December 5, 2000

(Filed December 6, 2000)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Summary Offences Procedure Amendment Regulations*, 2000 (No. 5).

R.R.S. c.S-63.1 Reg 2 amended

2 The Summary Offences Procedure Regulations, 1991 are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

New section 14.1

3 Section 14.1 is repealed and the following substituted:

"Designated offences re The Vehicle Administration Act

- **14.1** For the purposes of section 23.1 of *The Vehicle Administration Act*, the following are designated offences:
 - (a) the offences designated as offence notice ticket offences in section 6;
 - (b) offences pursuant to section 221, paragraphs 249(1)(a) and (b), subsections 249(3) and (4), subsection 252(1), paragraphs 253(a) and (b), subsection 254(5), subsections 255(2) and (3) and subsection 259(4) of the *Criminal Code*".

New section 17.1

4 The following section is added after section 17:

"Offence notice ticket re red light camera

17.1 An offence notice that relates to evidence obtained by a red light camera system authorized pursuant to *The Highway Traffic Act* may be served by sending it by ordinary mail to the defendant's address as shown on the records of the administrator as defined in *The Vehicle Administration Act*".

Appendix, Part 2 amended

- 5(1) Table 2 of Part 2 of the Appendix is amended in column 2 of item 5 by striking out "Failing to display a "D" sign or Wide Load or as specified" and substituting "Failing to comply with conditions and restrictions for over dimension vehicles and loads".
- (2) Table 7 of Part 2 of the Appendix is amended by adding the following item before item 8:
 - "7.1 Driving an unregistered vehicle 23(1) 500".

Appendix, Part 3, Table 1 amended

6(1) Table 1 of Part 3 of the Appendix is amended in the manner set forth in this section.

(2) Item 1 is repealed and the following substituted:

"1 Obstructing a licence plate 27(6)

"1.1 Speeding:

(a) in excess of 80 kilometres per hour

33(1)(a)

33(1)(b)

70 plus \$1 for each kilometre per hour in excess of the speed limit for speeds up to 30 km/hr above the speed limit and \$2 for each kilometre per hour in excess of the speed limit for speeds greater than 30 km/hr above the speed limit;

\$100

(b) in excess of the maximum speed indicated by signs on highway or at entrance to park

70 plus \$1 for each kilometre per hour in excess of the speed limit for speeds up to 30 km/hr above the speed limit and \$2 for each kilometre per hour in excess of the

speed limit for speeds greater than 30 km/hr above the speed limit".

(3) The following item is added after item 6:

"6.1 Exceeding 60 kilometres per hour when passing a stopped emergency vehicle

140 plus \$2 for each kilometre per hour in excess of the speed limit for speeds up to 30 km/hr above the speed limit and \$4 for each kilometre per hour in excess of the speed limit for speeds greater than 30 km/hr above the speed limit".

(4) The following items are added after item 62:

"62.1 Failing to extinguish loading lamps63.160

"62.2 Using amber beacon or flashing light when prohibited 63.2 60".

(5) The following item is added after item 81:

"81.1 Making a left turn on a one-way street on a red light when prohibited 65(5.1) 100".

Coming into force

- 7(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
- (2) Section 3 and subsection 5(2) come into force on January 1, 2001.
