SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 9/2004

The Personal Property Security Act, 1993

Section 71

Order in Council 161/2004, dated March 16, 2004

(Filed March 17, 2004)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Personal Property Security Amendment Regulations, 2004*.

2 *The Personal Property Security Regulations* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

Coming into force

5(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on April 5, 2004.

Section 10

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Milk Control Amendment Regulations, 2004 (No. 3)*.

R.R.S. c.M-15 Reg 1, Appendix, Part II amended

2 Clauses 3(1)(m) and (n) of Part II of the Appendix to *The Milk Control Regulations* are repealed and the following substituted:

“(m) in the case of class 5a milk:

- (i) \$5.4256 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$4.9592 per kilogram of protein; and
- (iii) \$0.0272 per kilogram of other solids;

“(n) in the case of class 5b milk:

- (i) \$5.4256 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$1.9329 per kilogram of protein; and
- (iii) \$1.9329 per kilogram of other solids”.

Coming into force

3 These regulations come into force on April 1, 2004.
