CHAPTER P-31 REG 18*The Provincial Lands Act*

Sections 20 and 22

Order in Council 844/2006, dated November 7, 2006

(Filed November 8, 2006)

Title**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Silver Lake Farm Land Regulations, 2006*.**Authorization****2** Subject to section 3, the Minister of Agriculture and Food is authorized to:

- (a) sell, lease, transfer or assign, for \$1 and other valuable consideration; or
- (b) gift or otherwise dispose of;

the lands described in the Appendix to these regulations or any interest in those lands, on those terms and conditions that the Minister of Agriculture and Food considers to be in the public interest, to the Northern Village of Green Lake.

Lands required for highways, etc.**3** Before making a disposition of the lands mentioned in section 2 or any interest in those lands, the Minister of Agriculture and Food shall:

- (a) determine whether any of those lands, part of those lands or interest in those lands is required for highways, roadways, gravel stockpile sites, waterworks, dams or utilities; and
- (b) if the Minister of Agriculture and Food determines that any of those lands, part of those lands or interest in those lands is required for the purposes mentioned in clause (a), make any disposition of those lands, any part of those lands or any interest in those lands, on those terms and conditions that the Minister of Agriculture and Food considers to be in the public interest, that the Minister of Agriculture and Food considers necessary to meet that requirement.

No fees**4** Notwithstanding any regulations made pursuant to *The Provincial Lands Act*, no fees are payable to the department for processing a disposition made pursuant to section 2.**Coming into force****5** These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

CHAPTER S-35.03 REG 1*The Saskatchewan Watershed Authority Act, 2005*

Section 78 and Subsection 98(1)

Order in Council 843/2006, dated November 7, 2006

(Filed November 8, 2006)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Saskatchewan Watershed Authority Regulations*.

Interpretation

2 In these regulations:

- (a) “**Act**” means *The Saskatchewan Watershed Authority Act, 2005*;
- (b) “**consumer price index**” or “**CPI**” means the annual average of the “all-items” Consumer Price Index for Saskatchewan for a calendar year, as released by Statistics Canada;
- (c) “**mg/L**” means milligrams per litre;
- (d) “**Table**” means a Table set out in the Appendix;
- (e) “**TDS**” means a measure of total dissolved solids in water expressed in milligrams per litre.

Application fees

3(1) A person applying to the corporation pursuant to a provision of the Act set out in Table 1 shall pay to the corporation, at the time the application is filed, the appropriate fee as set out in Table 1.

(2) The fee mentioned in subsection (1) is non-refundable.

Industrial water use charges

4(1) In this section and in Table 2, “**industrial water use**” means the use of water by any industry, including industries that are involved with processing, mineral exploration, mining, oil and gas exploration and recovery, manufacturing, gravel washing, hydraulic pressure testing and thermal power generation.

(2) Subject to subsection (3), a person using water for an industrial water use from a source or for a purpose mentioned in Table 2 shall pay to the corporation the appropriate charges as set out in Table 2.

- (3) The charges mentioned in subsection (1) do not apply to:
- (a) water used for primary agricultural production, including intensive livestock operations;
 - (b) industries that are connected to a municipal water distribution system and that receive their water from that system; or
 - (c) water with TDS greater than 4 000 mg/L obtained from the Blairmore or deeper ground water formations.
- (4) The corporation may apply a discount to a charge otherwise payable pursuant to this section if:
- (a) most of the water diverted for the industrial water use is returned to its original source; and
 - (b) the quality of diverted water returned is, in the opinion of the corporation, not significantly impaired.
- (5) The discounts that the corporation may apply pursuant to subsection (4) are those set out in Table 3.

Complaints re drainage works

- 5(1) The fee prescribed for the purpose of clause 81(2)(b) of the Act is \$200.
- (2) Subject to subsection (3), the fee mentioned in subsection (1) is non-refundable.
- (3) The corporation may refund all or a portion of the fee mentioned in subsection (1) if the complaint with respect to which the fee is paid is withdrawn before the corporation renders a decision with respect to the complaint.

ISC registration fees

6 If the corporation registers a notice, order or approval pursuant to the Act in the Saskatchewan Land Registry, the corporation shall collect from the owner of the affected lands the fees required to effect that registration in accordance with the schedule of fees established from time to time by the Information Services Corporation of Saskatchewan pursuant to *The Land Titles Act, 2000*.

Inspection of records

- 7(1) The corporation shall collect fees for information provided in response to requests made pursuant to *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* in accordance with *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations*.
- (2) The corporation may collect fees for information provided in response to requests that are not made pursuant to *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for a fee or at a rate not exceeding the fees or rates established pursuant to *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulations*.

Interest on overdue accounts

8 The corporation may collect interest on overdue fees, levies, rates or charges at a rate of 1.5 per cent per month, compounded monthly, or 19.56 per cent per year.

Exempt drainage works

9 Pursuant to clause 79(a) of the Act, drainage works situated wholly within a city, town, village or resort village are designated as exempt from the application of sections 80 and 81 of the Act with respect to injury, loss or damage suffered or anticipated to occur wholly within the city, town, village or resort village.

Well safety

10(1) While drilling a well, every well driller shall take those precautions that are necessary for the control of water and the safety of persons, livestock and other property.

(2) The owner of a well shall take those precautions that are necessary for the safety of persons, livestock and other property and for the prevention of damage by reason of the presence or escape of water.

Control of flowing wells

11(1) If the corporation requires the owner of a well to control the flow of water from the owner's well and the owner fails to do so, the corporation, or any person acting under the corporation's instructions, may:

- (a) enter on the land from which the water is flowing; and
- (b) conduct any operations required to control the flow of water that the corporation considers necessary.

(2) If operations to control the flow of water are conducted pursuant to subsection (1), the corporation may determine:

- (a) the reasonable cost of those operations;
- (b) the person or persons who are responsible for controlling the flow of water; and
- (c) the person or persons who are liable for the cost or any part of the cost of those operations.

(3) The amount of costs determined by the corporation pursuant to subsection (2) are a debt due and owing to the corporation by the persons whom the corporation determines are liable, and the corporation may recover those costs in any manner that is allowed by law for the recovery of debts due to the Crown.

(4) Notwithstanding subsection (2), if, in the corporation's opinion, the circumstances warrant, the corporation may pay all or part of the cost of the operations conducted pursuant to subsection (1).

Coming into force

12 These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

CHAPTER W-6 REG 2

The Water Power Act

Section 16

Order in Council 840/2006, dated November 7, 2006

(Filed November 8, 2006)

Title

- 1 These regulations may be cited as *The Water Power Rental Regulations*.

Interpretation

- 2 In these regulations:

- (a) “**Act**” means *The Water Power Act*;
- (b) “**actual cost**” means actual cost within the meaning of the Water Power Regulations;
- (c) “**consumer price index**” or “**CPI**” means the annual average of the “all-items” Consumer Price Index for Saskatchewan for a calendar year, as released by Statistics Canada;
- (d) “**generating capacity**” means a measure of the potential, expressed in units of kilowatts, for works to generate electrical power;
- (e) “**initial development**” means initial development within the meaning of the Water Power Regulations;

- (f) **“KVA rating”** means, with respect to a generator, a measure of apparent power, in units of kilovolt amperes, or the dimensional equivalent kilowatts, as specified on the manufacturer’s specification plate for the generator;
- (g) **“licence”** means an interim licence or a final licence, as the case may be, within the meaning of the Water Power Regulations;
- (h) **“licensee”** means a licensee within the meaning of the Water Power Regulations;
- (i) **“the Water Power Regulations”** means the Water Power Regulations, being Saskatchewan Regulations 906/68 as published in the Gazette of December 7, 1943 as a Schedule to Order in Council 1360/43;
- (j) **“works”** means works within the meaning of the Water Power Regulations.

Water rental

- 3(1) Every person who uses water for the purpose of producing water power using works, including persons who store water for the purpose of producing water power, shall pay a water rental to the corporation calculated in accordance with these regulations.
- (2) The water rental payable pursuant to subsection (1) for each calendar year, commencing January 1, 2006, is the greater of:
- (a) \$0.25 per quarter year per kilowatt of generating capacity for the works calculated by multiplying the manufacturer’s KVA rating by the power factor as specified on the manufacturer’s specification plate on each generator; and
 - (b) for the calendar year commencing:
 - (i) January 1, 2006, \$3.37948 per megawatt hour of power generated from the water used for the purpose of producing water power;
 - (ii) January 1, 2007, the product of:
 - (A) \$3.37948 per megawatt hour of power generated from the water used for the purpose of producing water power; and
 - (B) the ratio of the CPI for the year 2006 to the CPI for the year 2005; and
 - (iii) January 1, 2008, the product of:
 - (A) \$3.37948 per megawatt hour of power generated from the water used for the purpose of producing water power; and
 - (B) the ratio of the CPI for the year 2007 to the CPI for the year 2005.
- (3) Payments of water rental are to be made each successive quarter year or part of a quarter year during which the works generating the power are in operation or are on standby.
- (4) Every licensee shall submit to the corporation all data required to calculate the water rental payable pursuant to these regulations.

(5) For the purposes of these regulations, the calendar quarter years, payment dates and dates for submission of rental data are as follows:

<i>Quarter</i>	<i>Submission of Data and Payment due dates</i>
1 January 1 to March 31	April 30
2 April 1 to June 30	July 31
3 July 1 to September 30	October 31
4 October 1 to December 31	January 31.

(6) Notwithstanding subsection (3):

(a) the water rental calculated pursuant to subsection (2) is to begin on the date fixed in the interim licence for the completion of the initial development, whether or not that development is completed; and

(b) the first payment of the water rental for a new development is for the period between:

(i) the date fixed for the completion of the initial development; and

(ii) the end of the then current calendar year.

(7) Extensions of time for completion of the initial development for any cause whatsoever do not affect the terms and conditions set out in subsection (6).

(8) The corporation may charge and collect interest on any water rental not paid in full by the date it is payable pursuant to these regulations at a rate equal to:

(a) 1.5% per month, compounded monthly; or

(b) 19.56% per annum.

(9) Any water rental not paid in full by the date on which it is payable, together with any interest payable pursuant to subsection (8), is a debt due and owing to the corporation by the persons from whom it is payable, and the corporation may recover that debt in any manner allowed by law for the recovery of debts due to the Crown.

(10) The acceptance of any payment on account of water rentals or the waiver by the corporation of any default by the licensee of the terms and conditions to which a licensee is subject in any case is not a waiver, and is not deemed to be a waiver, of:

(a) any of the terms or conditions to which the licensee is subject; or

(b) any other default of the licensee of the terms and conditions to which the licensee is subject.

(11) For the purpose of determining the water rental payable, the corporation may:

- (a) determine the output of the licensee's works; and
- (b) for the purpose of determining the output of the licensee's works, require the licensee to produce to the corporation, immediately on demand, all relevant data.

(12) Every licensee generating electrical power shall:

- (a) install a recording wattmeter acceptable to the corporation; and
- (b) preserve and produce for inspection all records made by the wattmeter.

Coming into force

4 These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
