### SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 22/2007

#### *The Wildlife Act, 1998*

Subsection 83(2)

Minister's Order, dated April 11, 2007

(Filed April 12, 2007)

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Open Seasons Game Amendment Regulations, 2007*.

**R.R.S. c.W-13.12 Reg 1 amended**

**2** *The Open Seasons Game Regulations, 2004* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

**Section 2 amended**

**3 The following clause is added after clause 2(b):**

“(b.1) ‘antlerless moose’ means:

- (i) a female moose; or
- (ii) a moose born in the year in which it is being hunted”.

- (i) November 26 to December 1 in 2007; and
- (ii) November 24 to November 29 in 2008;

“(b) in Wildlife Management Zones 56 to 69, in Greenwater Lake, Meadow Lake, Narrow Hills, Wildcat Hill and Clarence-Steepbank Lakes Provincial Parks and in Round Lake and Bronson Forest Recreation Sites, from:

- (i) November 1 to December 1 in 2007; and
- (ii) November 1 to November 29 in 2008”.

**38(1)** No person shall hunt antlerless mule deer by any means other than a shotgun, muzzle-loading firearm, crossbow or bow and arrow during the antlerless mule deer shotgun special open seasons established pursuant to this section.

(2) A person who is the holder of a First Saskatchewan Resident Special Antlerless Mule Deer Licence may hunt a total of two antlerless mule deer in Regina/Moose Jaw and Saskatoon Wildlife Management Zones, from November 1 to December 4.

(3) A person who is the holder of a Second Saskatchewan Resident Special Antlerless Mule Deer Licence may hunt a total of two antlerless mule deer in Regina/Moose Jaw and Saskatoon Wildlife Management Zones, from November 1 to December 4”.

**24** These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

## Section 10

Board Order, dated April 13, 2007

(Filed April 13, 2007)

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Milk Control Amendment Regulations, 2007 (No. 4)*.

**R.R.S. c.M-15 Reg 1, Appendix amended**

**2** Subsection 3(1) of Part II of the Appendix to *The Milk Control Regulations* is amended:

**(a) by repealing clauses (a) and (b) and substituting the following:**

“(a) in the case of class 1a milk:

- (i) \$5.30 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$56.49 per hectolitre of skim milk;

“(b) in the case of class 1b milk:

- (i) \$5.30 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$56.49 per hectolitre of skim milk”; and

**(b) by repealing clauses (m) and (n) and substituting the following:**

“(m) in the case of class 5a milk:

- (i) \$3.5462 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$5.9213 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$1.3970 per kilogram of other solids;

“(n) in the case of class 5b milk:

- (i) \$3.5462 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$2.6345 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$2.6345 per kilogram of other solids”.

**Coming into force**

**3** These regulations come into force on May 1, 2007.
