**SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 27/2008***The Saskatchewan Assistance Act*

## Section 14

Order in Council 276/2008, dated April 10, 2008

(Filed April 18, 2008)

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Employment Supplement Amendment Regulations, 2008*.

**R.R.S. c.S-8 Reg 3 amended**

**2** *The Employment Supplement Regulations* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

**Section 6 amended**

**3** Clause 6(1)(b) is amended by striking out “\$3,500” and substituting “\$4,500”.

**Section 32 amended**

**4(1)** The description of the amount B<sup>18</sup> in subsection 32(2) is amended:

- (a) in clause (a) by striking out “\$220” and substituting “\$250”;
- (b) in clause (b) by striking out “\$264” and substituting “\$300”;
- (c) in clause (c) by striking out “\$308” and substituting “\$350”;
- (d) in clause (d) by striking out “\$352” and substituting “\$400”; and
- (e) in clause (e) by striking out “\$396” and substituting “\$450”.

**(2)** The formula in subsection 32(3) is amended by striking out “\$1,520” and substituting “\$1,820”.

**(3)** The description of the amount B<sup>13</sup> in subsection 32(4) is amended:

- (a) in clause (a) by striking out “\$55” and substituting “\$62.50”;
- (b) in clause (b) by striking out “\$66” and substituting “\$75”;
- (c) in clause (c) by striking out “\$77” and substituting “\$87.50”;
- (d) in clause (d) by striking out “\$88” and substituting “\$100”; and
- (e) in clause (e) by striking out “\$99” and substituting “\$112.50”.

**(4)** The formula in subsection 32(5) is amended by striking out “\$1,520” and substituting “\$1,820”.

**(5)** Subsection 32(6) is amended by striking out “\$3,500” and substituting “\$4,500”.

**Coming into force**

**5(1)** Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on May 1, 2008.

**(2)** If these regulations are filed with the Registrar of Regulations after May 1, 2008, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

## Section 10

Board Order, dated April 21, 2008

**Title**

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Milk Control Amendment Regulations, 2008 (No.4)*.

**R.R.S. c.M-15 Reg 1, Appendix amended**

2 **Subsection 3(1) of Part II of the Appendix to *The Milk Control Regulations* is amended:**

**(a) by repealing clauses (a) and (b) and substituting the following:**

“(a) in the case of class 1a milk:

- (i) \$5.30 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$63.35 per hectolitre of skim milk;

“(b) in the case of class 1b milk:

- (i) \$5.30 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$63.35 per hectolitre of skim milk”;

**(b) by repealing clauses (m) to (o) and substituting the following:**

“(m) in the case of class 5a milk:

- (i) \$3.0021 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$9.0364 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$0.1123 per kilogram of other solids;

“(n) in the case of class 5b milk:

- (i) \$3.0021 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$2.3906 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$2.3906 per kilogram of other solids;

“(o) in the case of class 5c milk:

- (i) \$3.6562 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$2.3906 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$2.3906 per kilogram of other solids”.

**Coming into force**

Subsection 83(2)

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Open Seasons Game Amendment Regulations, 2008*.

**R.R.S. c.W-13.12 Reg 1 amended**

**2** *The Open Seasons Game Regulations, 2004* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

**Section 12 amended**

**3** **Clauses 12(2)(a) and (b) are repealed and the following substituted:**

“(a) in Wildlife Management Zones 1 to 9, 15 to 23, 25 to 28, 30 to 41, 44 and 45, in Cypress Hills (West Block), Duck Mountain and Moose Mountain Provincial Parks, in that portion of Douglas Provincial Park located west of Diefenbaker Lake (Gordon McKenzie Arm), and in Last Mountain Lake National Wildlife Area, from November 17 to December 6 in 2008;

“(b) in Wildlife Management Zones 10 to 14, 24, 29, 42, 43, 46 to 55, 67, 68 South and 68 North, in Fort a la Corne and Horsehide Lake Wildlife Management Units, in Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park and in Bronson Forest Recreation Site, from November 1 to December 6 in 2008”.

**Section 13 amended**

**4** **Subsection 13(2) is amended:**

**(a) by repealing clause (a) and substituting the following:**

“(a) in Wildlife Management Zones 10 to 14, 24, 29, 43, 46, 47, 50 and 68 South, in Fort a la Corne Wildlife Management Unit, and in Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park, from September 1 to October 31”; **and**

**(b) by repealing clause (c).**

**Section 14 amended**

**5** **Clauses 14(2)(a) to (d) are repealed and the following substituted:**

“(a) in Regina/Moose Jaw and Saskatoon Wildlife Management Zones, from October 1 to December 4; and

“(b) in Wildlife Management Zones 10 to 14, 24, 29, 43, 46, 47, 50 and 68 South, in Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park, and in Fort a la Corne Wildlife Management Unit, from October 1 to October 31”.

**Section 16 amended**

**6** **Subsection 16(2) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(2) A person who is a Saskatchewan resident and the holder of a First Antlerless White-tailed Deer Licence may hunt a total of one antlerless white-tailed deer in Wildlife Management Zones 10 to 14, 24, 29, 43, 46, 47, 50 and 68 South, in Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park, and in Fort a la Corne Wildlife Management Unit, from November 1 to December 6 in 2008”.

**Section 19 amended****7 Subsection 19(3) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(3) A person who is the holder of a Saskatchewan Resident Elk Licence may hunt a total of one elk of either sex in that portion of Wildlife Management Zone 53 lying east of Provincial Highway No. 55 from November 17 to November 29 in 2008”.

**Section 29 amended****8 Clauses 29(3)(a) and (b) are repealed and the following substituted:**

“(a) in Wildlife Management Zones 35 to 37, 39, 40, 42, 43 and 45 to 76, and in Wildcat Hill, Athabasca Sand Dunes and Clearwater River Provincial Parks, from April 15 to June 30 and August 25 to October 14;

“(b) in Greenwater Lake and Duck Mountain Provincial Parks from April 15 to May 31 and September 20 to October 14”.

**Section 30 amended****9 Clauses 30(2)(a) and (b) are repealed and the following substituted:**

“(a) in Wildlife Management Zones 1 to 8, 15 to 19, 21 to 23, 25 to 28, 30, 33, 36, 40, 41, 42, 44, 45, 54 and 55, and in Regina/Moose Jaw and Saskatoon Wildlife Management Zones, from September 1 to October 31; and

“(b) in Cypress Hills (West Block) Provincial Park, and in that portion of Douglas Provincial Park lying west of Diefenbaker Lake (Gordon McKenzie Arm), from September 9 to October 31”.

**Section 34 amended****10 Subsection 34(2) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(2) A person who is the holder of a Saskatchewan Resident Special Mule Deer Licence may hunt a total of one mule deer of either sex:

(a) in Wildlife Management Zones 1 to 9, 15 to 23, 25 to 28, 30 to 42, 44, 45, 48, 49 and 51 to 55, in Cypress Hills (West Block) Provincial Park, and in that portion of Douglas Provincial Park lying west of Diefenbaker Lake (Gordon McKenzie Arm), from November 3 to November 15 in 2008; and

(b) in Wildlife Management Zones 10 to 14, 24, 29, 43, 46, 47, 50 and 68 South, in Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park, and in Fort a la Corne Wildlife Management Unit, from November 1 to December 6 in 2008”.

**New section 37****11 Section 37 is repealed and the following substituted:****“Antlerless mule deer rifle special open seasons**

**37(1)** No person shall hunt antlerless mule deer by any means other than the means prescribed in *The Wildlife Regulations, 1981* during the antlerless mule deer rifle special open seasons established pursuant to this section.

(2) A person who is the holder of a First Resident Special Antlerless Mule Deer Licence may hunt a total of two antlerless mule deer:

(a) in Wildlife Management Zones 1 to 9, 15 to 23, 25 to 28, 30 to 42, 44, 45, 48, 49 and 51 to 55, in Cypress Hills (West Block) Provincial Park, and in that portion of Douglas Provincial Park lying west of Diefenbaker Lake (Gordon McKenzie Arm), from November 10 to December 6 in 2008; and

- (b) in Wildlife Management Zones 10 to 14, 24, 29, 43, 46, 47, 50 and 68 South, and in Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park and in Fort a la Corne Wildlife Management Unit, from November 1 to December 6 in 2008.
- (3) A person who is the holder of a Second Saskatchewan Resident Special Antlerless Mule Deer Licence may hunt a total of two antlerless mule deer:
- (a) in Wildlife Management Zones 1 to 9, 15 to 23, 25 to 28, 30 to 42, 44, 45, 48, 49 and 51 to 55, in Cypress Hills (West Block) Provincial Park, and in that portion of Douglas Provincial Park lying west of Diefenbaker Lake (Gordon McKenzie Arm), from November 10 to December 6 in 2008; and
- (b) in Wildlife Management Zones 10 to 14, 24, 29, 43, 46, 47, 50 and 68 South, in Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park and in Fort a la Corne Wildlife Management Unit, from November 1 to December 6 in 2008”.

**Section 57 amended**

**12(1) Subsection 57(2) is amended in the portion preceding clause (a) by adding “or a Canadian Resident Game Bird Licence” after “Saskatchewan Resident Game Bird Licence”.**

**(2) Subsection 57(3) is amended in the portion preceding clause (a) by striking out “a Canadian Resident Game Bird Licence or”.**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Northern Municipalities General Regulations (No. 1) Amendment Regulations, 2008*.
