SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 72/2008

The Securities Act, 1988

Section 154

Commission Order, dated July 3, 2008

(Filed August 19, 2008)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as The Securities Commission (Adoption of National Instruments) Amendment Regulations, 2008 (No. 6).

R.R.S. c.S-42.2 Reg 3 amended

2 The Securities Commission (Adoption of National Instruments) Regulations are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

Part V of Appendix amended

- 3 Form 81-101F2 of Part V of the Appendix is amended in Item 6 by adding the following subsection after subsection (1):
- "(1.1) If the valuation principles and practices established by the manager differ from Canadian GAAP, describe the differences".

Part VI of Appendix amended

- 4(1) Part VI of the Appendix is amended in the manner set forth in this section.
- (2) Section 1.1 is amended by adding the following definition after the definition of "mutual fund conflict of interest reporting requirements":
 - "'net asset value' means the value of the total assets of the investment fund less the value of the total liabilities of the investment fund, as at a specific date, determined in accordance with Part 14 of National Instrument 81-106 Investment Fund Continuous Disclosure".
- (3) Subsection 9.4(3) is repealed.
- (4) Subsection 10.4(4) is repealed.

Part XII of Appendix amended

- 5 Form 41-101F2 of Part XII of the Appendix is amended in Item 20.2:
 - (a) by striking out "and" after clause (a); and
 - (b) by adding the following after clause (a):
 - "(a.1) if the valuation principles and practices established by the manager differ from the Canadian GAAP, describe the differences; and".

Part XL of Appendix amended

- **6**(1) Part XL of the Appendix is amended in the manner set forth in this section.
- (2) Section 1.1 is amended by repealing the definition of "net asset value" and substituting the following:
 - "'net asset value' means the value of the total assets of the investment fund less the value of the total liabilities of the investment fund, as at a specific date, determined in accordance with Part 14".

(3) Section 2.9 is amended:

- (a) in subclause (4)(a)(i) by striking out "and a statement of investment portfolio"; and
- (b) in subclause (4)(b)(i) by striking out "and a statement of investment portfolio".

(4) Section 2.10 is amended:

- (a) by repealing clause (a) and substituting the following:
- "(a) the investment fund terminating or ceasing to be a reporting issuer"; and
- (b) by repealing clause (h) and substituting the following:
- "(h) if applicable, the names of each party that terminated or ceased to be a reporting issuer following the transaction and of each continuing entity".
- (5) Section 3.1 is amended in item 15 by striking out "net asset value" and substituting "net assets".
- (6) Section 3.2 is amended by adding the following item after item 10:
- "10.1 commissions and other portfolio transaction costs".
- (7) Section 3.6 is amended:
 - (a) by repealing item (1)3. and substituting the following:
- "3. to the extent the amount is ascertainable, the soft dollar portion of the total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs paid or payable to dealers by the investment fund, where the soft dollar portion is the amount paid or payable for goods and services other than order execution"; and
 - (b) by adding the following item after item (1)4.:
- "5. the net asset value per security as at the date of the financial statements compared to the net assets per security as shown on the statement of net assets, and an explanation of each of the differences between those amounts".
- (8) Subsection 3.11(2) is amended by striking out "net asset value per security" and substituting "net assets per security".
- (9) Clause 8.2(c) is amended by striking out "net asset value" and substituting "net assets".
- (10) Section 8.4 is amended by striking out "net asset value" and substituting "net assets".
- (11) Section 9.2 is repealed and the following substituted:
- **"9.2 Requirement to File Annual Information Form-** An investment fund must file an annual information form if the investment fund has not obtained a receipt for a prospectus during the last 12 months preceding its financial year end".

(12) Section 10.3 is amended by striking out "reporting issuer" and substituting "reporting issuer or the equivalent of a reporting issuer in a foreign jurisdiction".

(13) Section 14.2 is amended:

- (a) by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following:
- "(1) The net asset value of an investment fund must be calculated using the fair value of the investment fund's assets and liabilities.
- "(1.1) The net asset value of an investment fund must include the income and expenses of the investment fund accrued up to the date of calculation of the net asset value.
- "(1.2) For the purposes of subsection (1), fair value means:
 - (a) the market value based on reported prices and quotations in an active market; or
 - (b) if the market value is not available, or the manager of the investment fund believes that it is unreliable, a value that is fair and reasonable in all the relevant circumstances.
- "(1.3) The manager of an investment fund must:
 - (a) establish and maintain appropriate written policies and procedures for determining the fair value of the investment fund's assets and liabilities; and
 - (b) consistently follow those policies and procedures.
- "(1.4) The manager of an investment fund must maintain a record of the determination of fair value and the reasons supporting that determination";
 - (b) in subsection (2) by striking out "Despite subsection (1), for" and substituting "For"; and
 - (c) in subsection (5) by striking out "Despite subsection (3)" and substituting "Despite paragraph 3(a)".
- (14) Paragraph 15.1(1)(a)(i)(A) is repealed and the following substituted:
 - "(A) total expenses of the investment fund, excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs, before income taxes, for the financial year or interim period, as shown on its statement of operations".

(15) Section 15.2 is amended:

- (a) by repealing subclause (1)(a)(i) and substituting the following:
 - "(i) multiplying the total expenses of each underlying investment fund, excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs, before income taxes, for the financial year or interim period, by"; and
- (b) by repealing clause (1)(b) and substituting the following:
- "(b) the total expenses of the investment fund, excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs, before income taxes, for the period".

(16) Sections 18.2, 18.3, 18.4 and 18.5 are repealed.

(17) Form 81-106F1 is amended:

(a) in Item 1 of Part A by adding the following clause after clause (e):

"(f) Terminology

All references to 'net assets' or 'net assets per security' in this Form are references to net assets determined in accordance with Canadian GAAP as presented in the financial statements of the investment fund. All references to 'net asset value' or 'net asset value per security' in this Form are references to net asset value determined in accordance with Part 14 of the Instrument.

Investment funds must use net assets as shown on the financial statements in the 'The Fund's Net Assets per [Unit/Share]' table. All other calculations for the purposes of the MRFP must be made using net asset value":

(b) in Item 3 of Part B:

(i) in subsection 3.1(1):

- (A) by striking out "This information is derived from the Fund's audited annual financial statements"; and
- **(B)** by repealing the Tables titled "The Fund's Net Asset Value (NAV) per [Unit/Share]" and "Ratios and Supplemental Data" and substituting the following Tables:

"Ratios and Supplemental Data

- (1) This information is provided as at [insert date of end of financial year] of the year shown.
- (2) Management expense ratio is based on total expenses (excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs) for the stated period and is expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the period.
- (3) The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the period.
- (4) The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio adviser manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the year. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a year, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the year, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the year. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund";

(ii) by repealing subsection 3.1(2);

(iii) by repealing subsection 3.1(6) and substituting the following:

"(6) Except for net assets, net value and distributions, calculate per unit/share values on the basis of the weighted average number of unit/shares outstanding over the financial period";

(iv) by repealing subsection 3.1(12) and substituting the following:

- "(12)(a) Calculate the trading expense ratio by dividing:
 - (i) the total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs disclosed in the statement of operations, by;
 - (ii) the same denominator used to calculate the management expense ratio.
 - (b) If an investment fund invests in securities of other investment funds, calculate the trading expense ratio using the methodology required for the calculation of the management expense ratio in section 15.2 of the Instrument, making reasonable assumptions or estimates when necessary";

(v) by repealing subsection 3.1(13) and substituting the following:

- "(13) Provide the closing market price only if the investment fund is traded on an exchange";
 - (vi) by repealing the portion of section 3.2 preceding the Table titled "Financial & Operating Highlights (with comparative figures)" and substituting the following:

"An investment fund that is a scholarship plan must comply with Item 3.1, except that the following table must replace 'The Fund's Net Assets per [Unit/Share]' table and the 'Ratios and Supplemental Data' table"; and

(vii) by repealing the Instruction in section 3.3 and substituting the following:

"The disclosure must list the major services paid for out of the management fees, including portfolio adviser compensation, waived or absorbed expenses, trailing commissions and sales commissions, if applicable. Services may be grouped together so that commercially sensitive information, such as the specific compensation paid to a portfolio adviser or the manager's profit, is not determinable";

(c) in Item 4 of Part B:

- (i) by repealing subsection 4.1(3) and substituting the following:
- "(3) Set out in the footnotes to the chart or table required by this Item the assumptions relevant to the calculation of the performance information, including any assumptions or estimates made in order to calculate the return on the short portfolio, if applicable. Include a statement of the significance of the assumption that distributions are reinvested for taxable investments"; and
 - (ii) by striking out "or" at the end of clause 4.3(1)(a) and substituting "and";
 - (d) in Item 5 of Part B:
 - (i) in clause (2)(b) by striking out "net assets" and substituting "net asset value";
 - (ii) in clause (2)(d) by striking out "net assets" and substituting "net asset value";
 - (iii) in Instruction (8):
 - (A) by striking out "another" and substituting "one other"; and
 - (B) by striking out "net assets" and substituting "net asset value"; and
 - (iv) by adding the following Instruction after Instruction (9):
- "(10) A labour sponsored or venture capital fund must disclose its top 25 positions, but is not required to express any of its venture investments as a percentage of the fund's net asset value if it complies with the conditions in Part 8 of the Instrument to be exempt from disclosing the individual current values of venture investments in its statement of investment portfolio".

Coming into force

- 7(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on September 8, 2008.
- (2) If these regulations are filed with the Registrar of Regulations after September 8, 2008, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

1 These regulations may be cited as The Milk Control Amendment Regulations, 2008 (No.8).

 - (a) by repealing clauses (a) and (b) and substituting the following:
 - "(a) in the case of class 1a milk:
 - (i) \$5.30 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$66.29 per hectolitre of skim milk;
 - "(b) in the case of class 1b milk:
 - (i) \$5.30 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$66.29 per hectolitre of skim milk";
 - (b) by repealing clauses (d) to (g) and substituting the following:
 - "(d) in the case of class 2 milk:
 - (i) \$7.4482 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$5.5744 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$5.5744 per kilogram of other solids;
 - "(e) in the case of class 3a milk:
 - (i) \$7.4482 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$13.0375 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$0.8684 per kilogram of other solids;
 - "(f) in the case of class 3b milk:
 - (i) \$7.4482 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$12.7848 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$0.8524 per kilogram of other solids;

- "(g) in the case of class 4a milk:
 - (i) \$7.4482 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of other solids";

(c) by repealing clause (h) and substituting the following:

- "(h) in the case of class 4b milk:
 - (i) \$7.4482 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of other solids";

(d) by repealing clauses (j) and (k) and substituting the following:

- "(j) in the case of class 4d milk:
 - (i) \$7.4482 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of other solids;
- "(k) in the case of class 4d(i) milk:
 - (i) \$7.4482 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$5.1760 per kilogram of other solids"; and

(e) by repealing clauses (m) to (o) and substituting the following:

- "(m) in the case of class 5a milk:
 - (i) \$3.7450 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$8.4445 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$0.1628 per kilogram of other solids;
- "(n) in the case of class 5b milk:
 - (i) \$3.7450 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$2.7590 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$2.7590 per kilogram of other solids;
- "(o) in the case of class 5c milk:
 - (i) \$4.1133 per kilogram of butterfat;
 - (ii) \$2.7590 per kilogram of protein;
 - (iii) \$2.7590 per kilogram of other solids".
