**SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 101/2009***The Summary Offences Procedure Act, 1990*

## Section 55

Order in Council 755/2009, dated November 13, 2009

(Filed November 13, 2009)

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Summary Offences Procedure Amendment Regulations, 2009 (No.3)*.

**R.R.S. c.S-63.1 Reg 2 amended**

**2** *The Summary Offences Procedure Regulations, 1991* are amended in the manner set out in these regulations.

**Section 10 amended**

**3 Subsection 10(2) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(2) The ticket consists of eight parts:

- (a) Parts 1 and 2 to be used for laying an information and as the certificate of service;
- (b) Part 3 to be used to issue an offence notice with respect to any ticket offence mentioned in section 6;
- (c) Part 4 to be used by the person to whom an offence notice is directed:
  - (i) to indicate a not guilty plea and to request a trial date pursuant to section 19 of the Act;
  - (ii) to indicate a guilty plea and to request a date to make submissions pursuant to section 21 of the Act;
  - (iii) to indicate a guilty plea and for payment of a specified penalty sum pursuant to section 10 of the Act; or
  - (iv) to indicate a guilty plea and to request registration in the fine option program pursuant to section 11 of the Act;
- (d) Part 5 to be used to issue a summons with respect to a ticket offence mentioned in section 5;
- (e) Part 6 to be used by the person to whom the summons is directed to indicate a guilty plea and for:
  - (i) payment of a specified penalty sum pursuant to section 10 of the Act; or
  - (ii) registration in the fine option program pursuant to section 11 of the Act;

- (f) Part 7 to be used as the police record of the information; and
- (g) Part 8 to be used as the peace officer's case summary notes".

**Section 11 amended**

**4(1) Subsection 11(1) is amended by striking out "7 and 8" and substituting "5 and 6".**

**(2) Subsection 11(2) is amended by striking out "9 and 10" and substituting "3 and 4".**

**(3) Subsection 11(3) is amended in the portion preceding clause (a) by striking out "5 and 6" and substituting "7 and 8".**

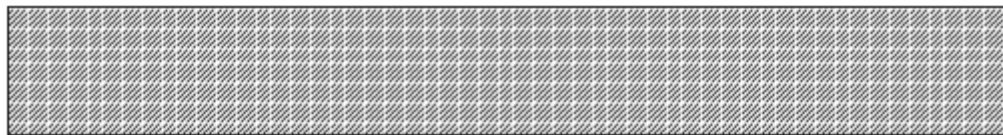
