Section 10

Board Order, dated December 22, 2009

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Milk Control Amendment Regulations, 2009* (No. 12).

R.R.S. c.M-15 Reg 1, Appendix amended

2 Subsection 3(1) of Part II of the Appendix to *The Milk Control Regulations* is amended by repealing clauses (l) to (o) and substituting the following:

“(l) in the case of class 4m milk:

- (i) \$0.7000 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$0.7000 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$0.7000 per kilogram of other solids;

“(m) in the case of class 5a milk:

- (i) \$3.4262 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$5.9628 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$0.3676 per kilogram of other solids;

“(n) in the case of class 5b milk:

- (i) \$3.4262 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$2.1853 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$2.1853 per kilogram of other solids;

“(o) in the case of class 5c milk:

- (i) \$4.1431 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$2.1853 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$2.1853 per kilogram of other solids”.

Coming into force

3 These regulations come into force on January 1, 2010.
