SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 17/2010*The Crop Insurance Act*

Section 22

Order in Council 145/2010, dated March 17, 2010

(Filed March 18, 2010)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Crop Insurance Amendment Regulations, 2010*.

R.R.S. c.C-47.2 Reg 1 amended

2 *The Crop Insurance Regulations* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

Section 2 amended

3 **The following subclauses are added after subclause 2(f)(ix):**

- “(x) camelina;
- “(xi) non-irrigated dry beans (navy);
- “(xii) soybeans;
- “(xiii) honey”.

Section 10 amended

4 **Subsection 10(1.1) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(1.1) The total coverage or guaranteed production, in kilograms or in tonnes per acre for each insurable crop covered by:

- (a) section 11.7, is not more than 70% of the average yield for a period of years as established from time to time by the corporation; and
- (b) section 11.92, is not more than 90% of the average yield for a period of years as established from time to time by the corporation”.

Section 11.7 amended

5(1) Subsection 11.7(1) is amended:

- (a) **by striking out “and” after clause (c);**
- (b) **in clause (d) by striking out “timothy hay” and substituting “the crops set out in subsection (2)”;**
- (c) **by adding “and” after clause (d); and**
- (d) **by adding the following clause after clause (d):**
 - “(e) the maximum coverage level available for new crops is 70%”.

(2) Subsection 11.7(2) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(2) An adjustment to the quantity of the harvested production of the following crops is to be made when the quality of harvested production falls below the standard grade for the industry as determined by the corporation:

- (a) non-irrigated dry beans (pinto);
- (b) non-irrigated dry beans (black);
- (c) non-irrigated dry beans (navy);
- (d) timothy hay”.

Appendix, Form A amended**6 Subsection 1(2) in Form A of the Appendix is amended:****(a) by repealing clause (b) and substituting the following:**

“(b) ‘coverage per acre’ means:

- (i) subject to subclauses (ii) and (iii), in the case of individual coverage, not more than 80% of the long-term average yield per acre;
- (ii) coverage pursuant to the crop averaging program; and
- (iii) in the case of new crops, not more than 70% of the long-term average yield per acre;

for the insured crop as determined by the corporation in the manner prescribed in the regulations”;

(b) by adding the following paragraphs after paragraph (d)(i)(HH):

- “(II) non-irrigated dry beans (pinto), No.1 Canada;
- “(JJ) non-irrigated dry beans (black), No.1 Canada;
- “(KK) non-irrigated dry beans (navy), No.1 Canada;
- “(LL) timothy hay, choice”;

(c) in clause (m) by adding “, wild boars” after “bison”.**Coming into force**

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Milk Control Amendment Regulations, 2010 (No.3)*.

2 **Clauses 3(1)(m) to (o) of Part II of the Appendix to *The Milk Control Regulations* are repealed and the following substituted:**

“(m) in the case of class 5a milk:

- (i) \$3.3559 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$5.9592 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$0.4789 per kilogram of other solids;

“(n) in the case of class 5b milk:

- (i) \$3.3559 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$2.1069 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$2.1069 per kilogram of other solids;

“(o) in the case of class 5c milk:

- (i) \$3.7281 per kilogram of butterfat;
- (ii) \$1.9328 per kilogram of protein;
- (iii) \$1.9328 per kilogram of other solids”.

“Designated Treasury Board Crown corporation

3.1 The Saskatchewan Communications Network Corporation continued pursuant to *The Communications Network Corporation Act* is designated as a designated Treasury Board Crown corporation for the purposes of the Act”.
