SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 62/96

The Provincial Lands Act Sections 20 and 22

Order in Council 577/96, dated August 7, 1996

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Provincial Lands Amendment Regulations, 1996.*

Sask. Reg.145/68, Part II amended

2 The following section is added after section 7 of Part II of the Provincial Lands Regulations, being Saskatchewan Regulations 145/68:

"WGTPP Lands

8(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Part, the minister may sell lands for which the minister is eligible to receive the transition payment pursuant to the *Western Grain Transition Payments Act* (Canada) and the regulations made pursuant to that Act, prior to receiving the final transition payment pursuant to that Act and those regulations.

(2) The purchase price for lands mentioned in subsection (1) is:

(a) the market value of the lands as of February 27, 1995 as determined in accordance with Schedule Two, less the amount of the transition payment mentioned in subsection (1) actually received by the minister; or

(b) an amount agreed to by the purchaser and the minister prior to February 27, 1995, less the amount of the transition payment mentioned in subsection (1) actually received by the minister.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), the purchaser shall, at the time of purchase, pay the full amount of the market value of the lands as of February 27, 1995 as determined in accordance with Schedule Two, or the full amount agreed to by the purchaser and the minister prior to February 27, 1995, as the case may be.

(4) When the minister receives:

(a) the interim payment of the transition payment mentioned in subsection (1), the minister shall refund to the purchaser an amount equal to the amount of the interim payment actually received by the minister, without interest;

(b) the final payment of the transition payment mentioned in subsection (1), the minister shall refund to the purchaser an amount equal to the amount of the final payment actually received by the minister, without interest.
